Evening Child Care during Class by Reservation

Evening child care services for children whose parent/guardians are taking or teaching evening classes is available at the OCCC Child Development Center and Lab School. The CDCLS is licensed as a Three-Star facility with the state of Oklahoma and is accredited with the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC)

Ages of Children

Because this is a pilot program for Spring 2008, we will consider any child from infant to age 8 years old. Please contact the CDCLS Office for specifics and to let us know your child care needs.

Days and hours of Service

Child care is offered Monday – Wednesday, 5:15 p.m. – 8:15 p.m. Other days will be considered as needed. Please voice your request with the CDCLS Office.

Cost

During the Spring of 2008 there is no enrollment fee. The cost of child care is \$10.00 per evening for each child. Payments are made in advance. A Payment Plan is developed depending on the needs of the family and a total balance is calculated based on the full semester. Monthly pre-paid payments are required. Payments are made in the OCCC Bursar Office. The CDCLS Office does not handle payments.

The Reservation Room

The term Reservation Room reflects the type of program offered by the CDCLS to meet the needs of students requiring child care while the student attends class. Students make a semester-long reservation for their child with the CDCLS. The reservation guarantees a place for the child every evening the student is in class. A pre-enrollment process provides the CDCLS with all the necessary information required by state licensing and national accreditation systems when caring for young children.
