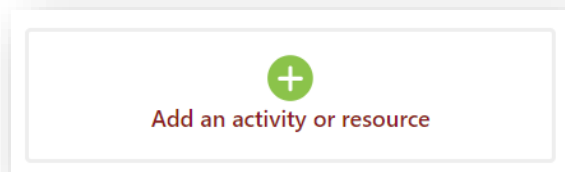


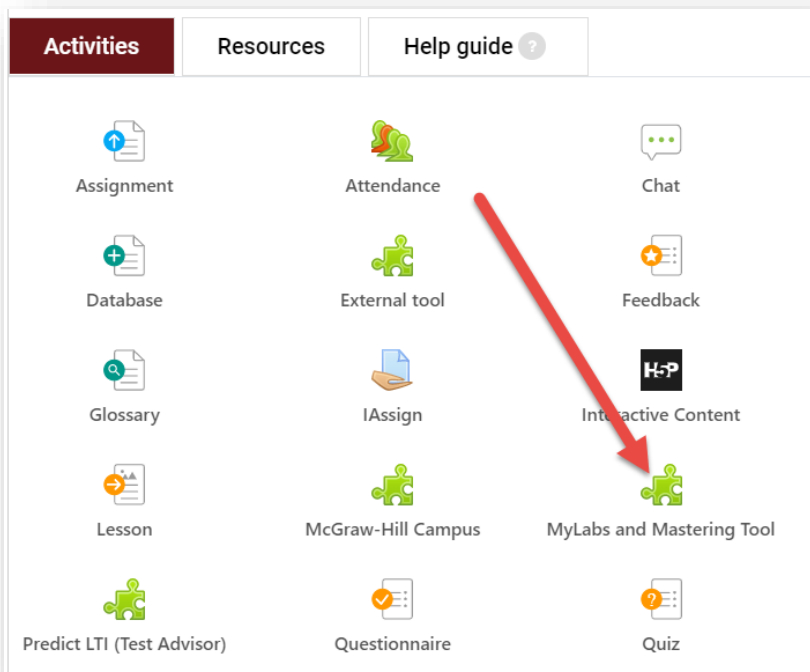
Connecting Pearson MyLabs and Moodle

It is now possible to connect your Moodle and Pearson MyLabs sections together. This allows you to sync grades from MyLabs section to your Moodle gradebook, and also provides an easier registration process for your students.


To begin the setup, first login to Moodle and navigate to the course you wish to pair with MyLabs. In your Moodle section, go to the topic where you wish to place the MyLabs tool, and select **Add an activity or resource** at the bottom of the topic.



From the list of activities, select the **MyLabs and Mastering Tool**.



Enter a name for your MyLabs activity in the **Name** field, but do not save yet!




Adding a new External tool



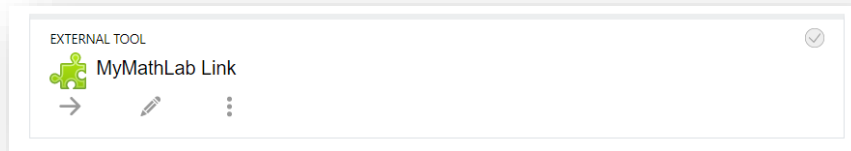

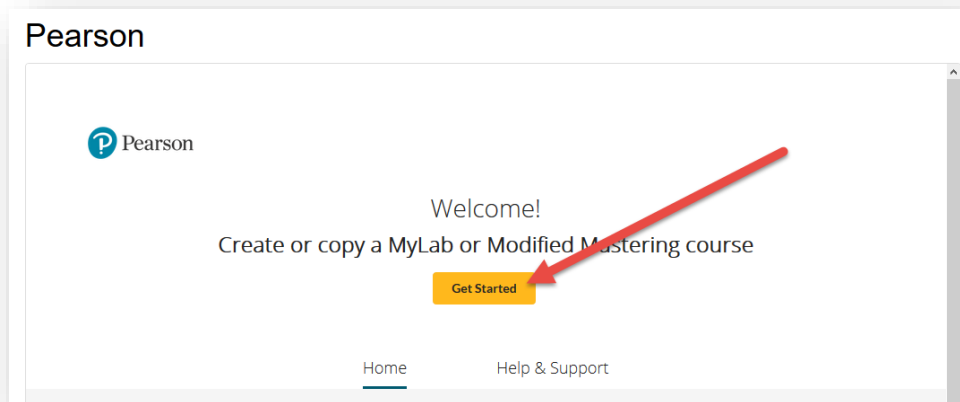

This will add a **MyLabs and Mastering Tool** activity into the topic where you began the process.




Open this activity now, and select the **Get Started** button.



After logging in, select **Get Started**.




Congratulations! Your accounts are now linked.
