

¹Theatre majors must take either THTR 1403 (Stagecraft), or THTR 1203 (Costume Craft) which is offered in Fall Even Years. This requirement may be met by transfer of TA 2113 (Introduction to Technical Theatre.) In this case, a lower level elective may replace this requirement in one Fall term.

²Students must earn 40 hours of upper-level elective credit. Upper-level THTR electives (see catalog) are offered each term. USAO Theatre Arts majors are encouraged to complete upper-level courses in interdisciplinary study that will strengthen their theatre training (Communication, Music, Art, Photography, Psychology, Speech/Language Pathology, Physical Education, Education, History, Language and Literature, and other fields).

³Students are strongly encouraged to take USAO's (3) World Thought and Culture General Education courses as part of this interdisciplinary major.
