## **Oklahoma Tuition Aid Grant (OTAG)**

- The Oklahoma Tuition Aid Grant (OTAG) is a grant offered by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education (OSRHE) to residents of Oklahoma who attend public and private colleges and universities, and career technology centers.
- An application for OTAG is made by submitting the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at <u>www.fafsa.gov</u>
- For consideration of the OTAG grant, a student should submit the FAFSA application as soon as possible after October 1<sup>st</sup>, but before December 1<sup>st</sup> each year.
- Eligibility for OTAG is based on several factors:
  - The students Expected Family Contribution (EFC) number is 1700 or lower.
  - The student is eligible for the Federal Pell Grant
  - The student is a resident of the state of Oklahoma
  - The student is enrolled at least half-time (6 or more credit hours)
  - The student is enrolled in an eligible degree program
  - The student is meeting satisfactory academic progress standards
  - The FAFSA application receipt date is no later than the annual filing deadline of December 1<sup>st</sup>.
