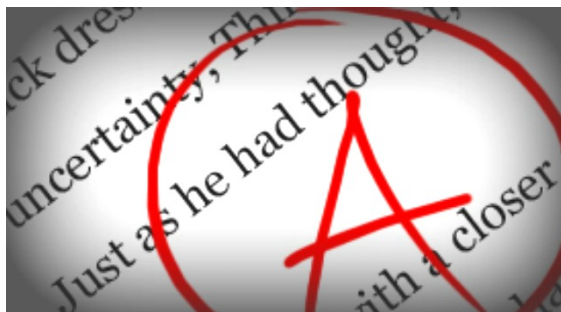

- Adopting definitions used by Achieving the Dream, course success is defined as a student earning a(n) A, B, C or S as their final grade in a course.

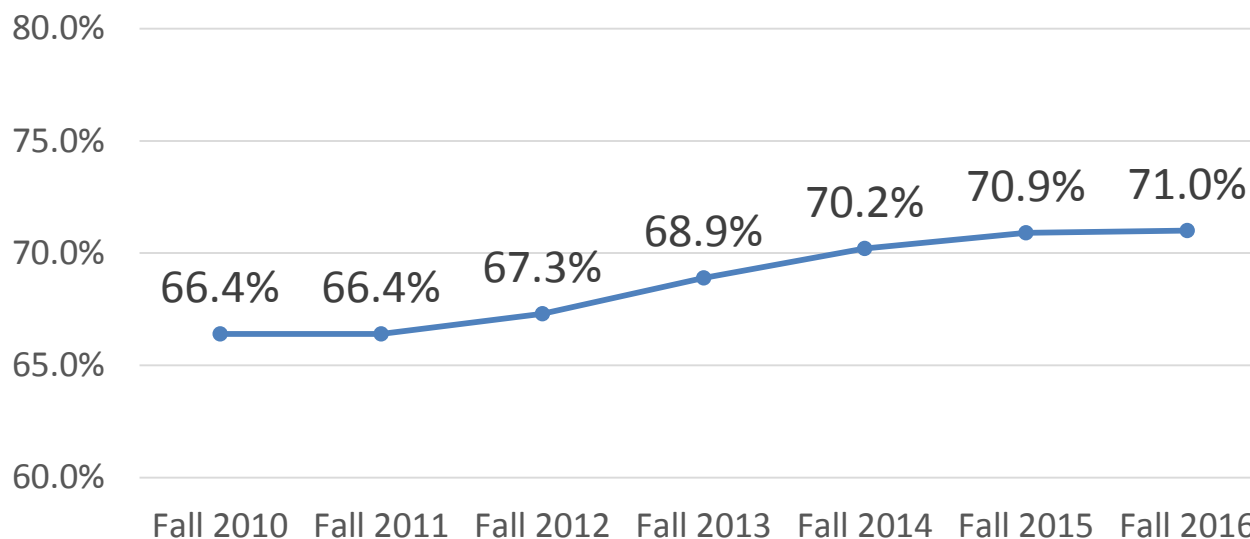


## What is a success rate?

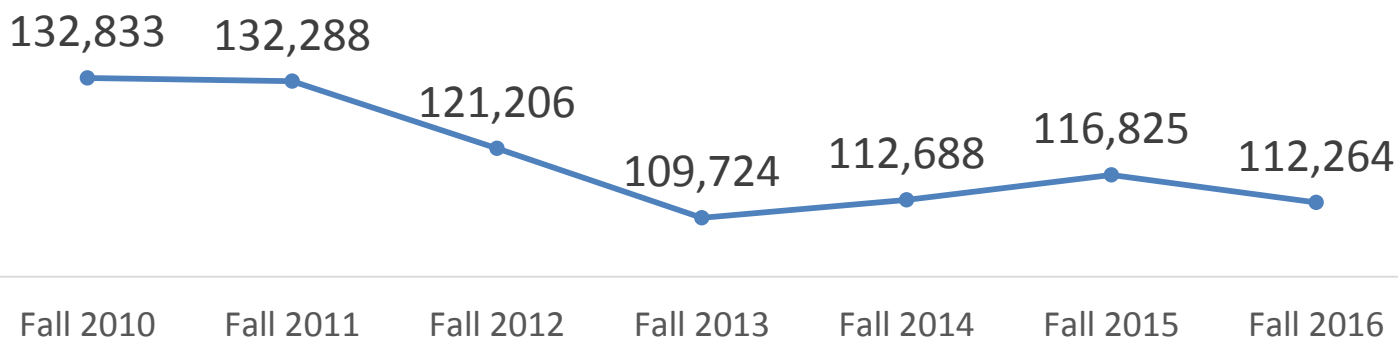
- The number of students in a given population that received an A, B, C or S as percent of the entire population. Students receiving an Incomplete grade or Auditing the course were not included in the aggregate.

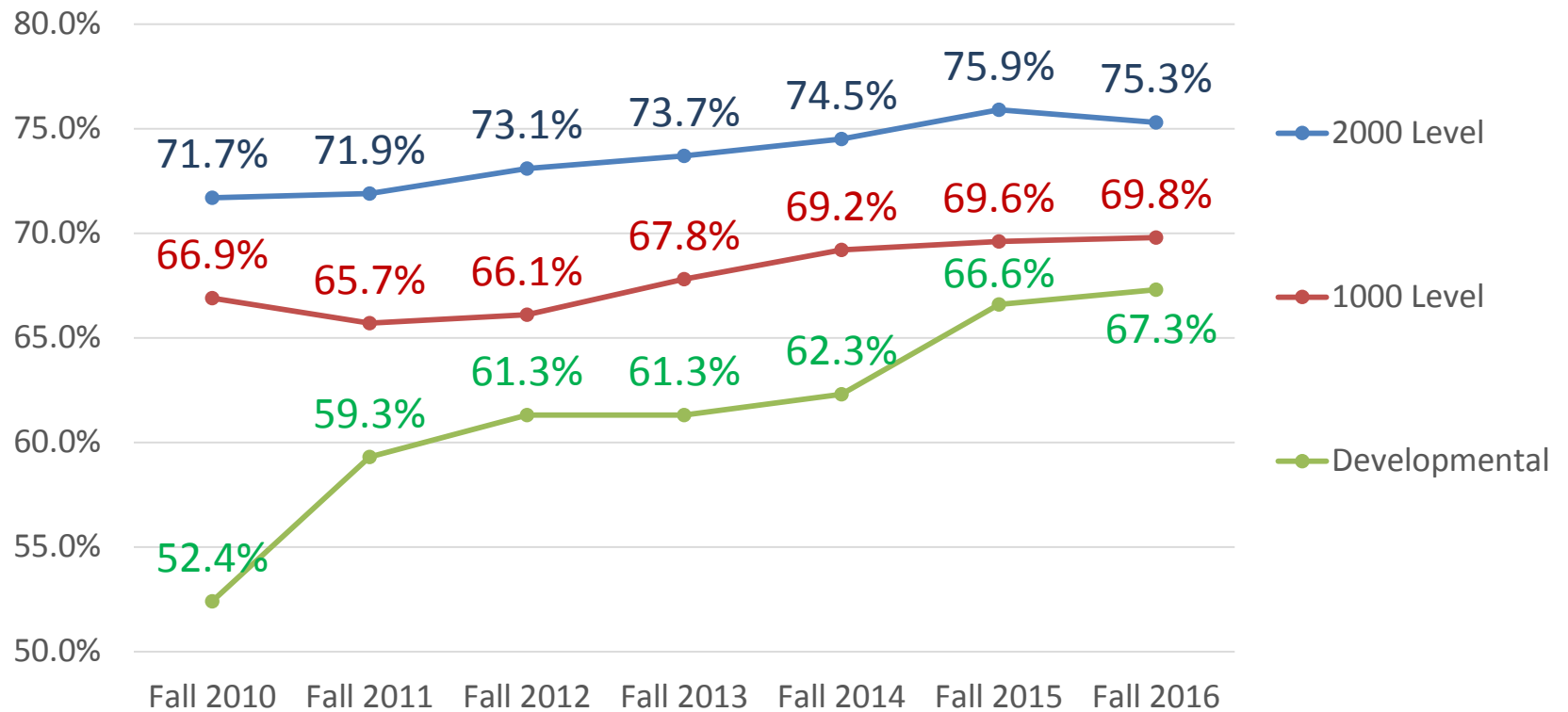
Overall Fall Success Rates



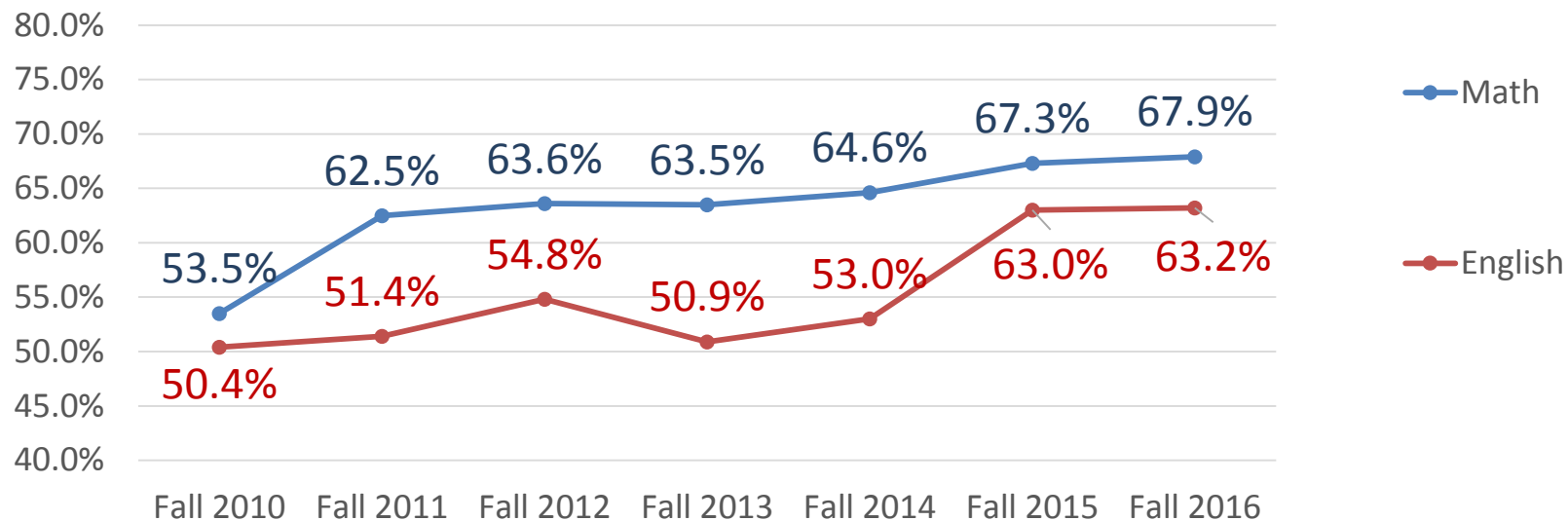
Overall Fall Credit Hours



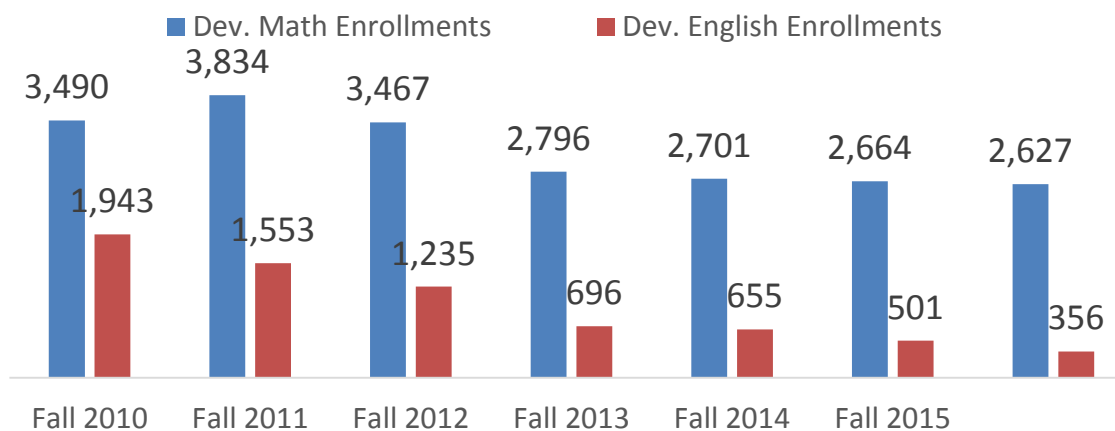
### Overall Fall Success Rates – By Course Level



## Overall Fall Success Rates – By Developmental Course Subjects

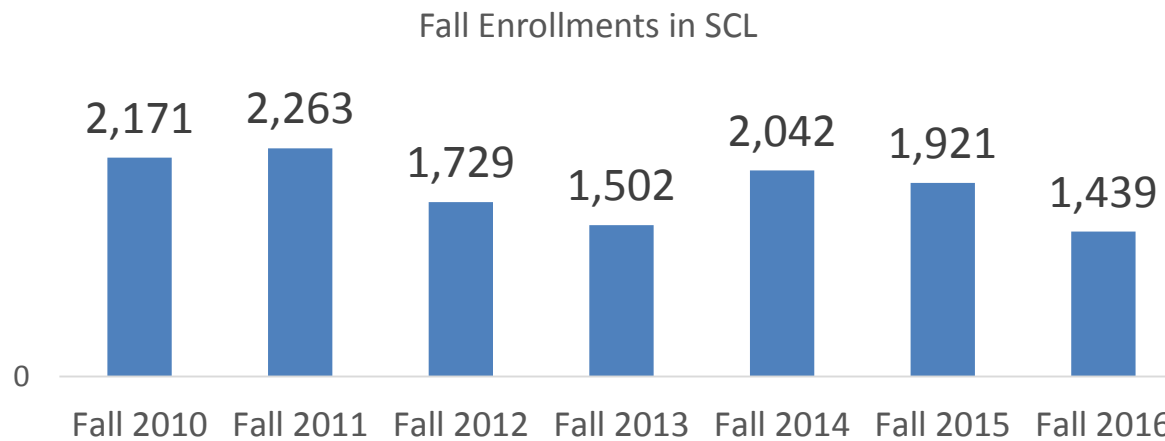
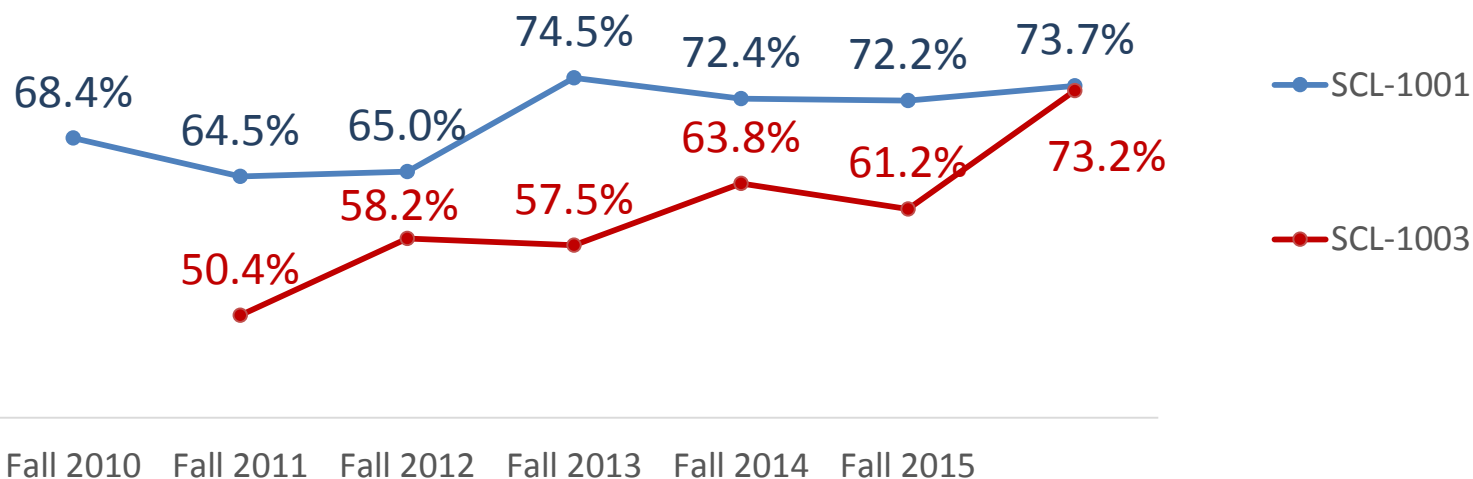

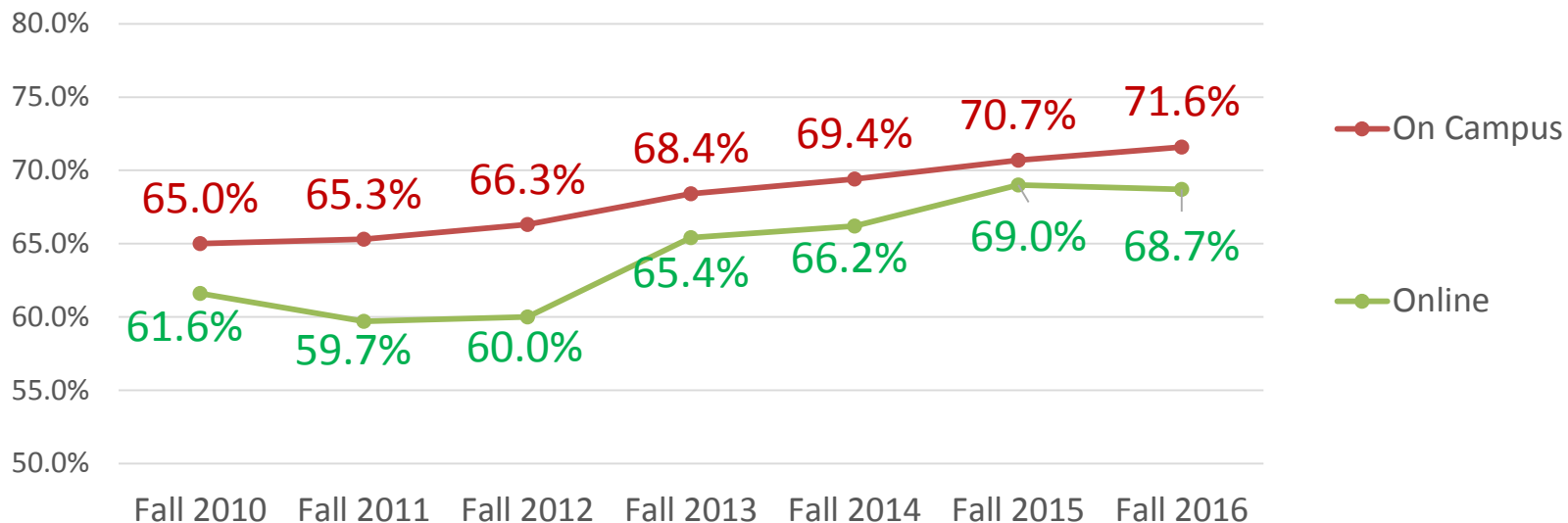

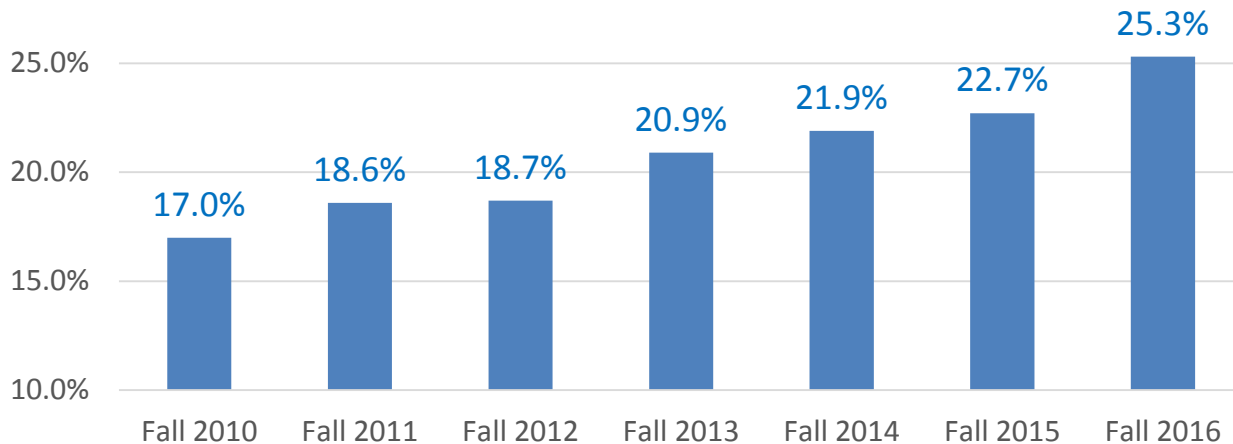


### Overall Fall Success Rates – By Enrollment Location

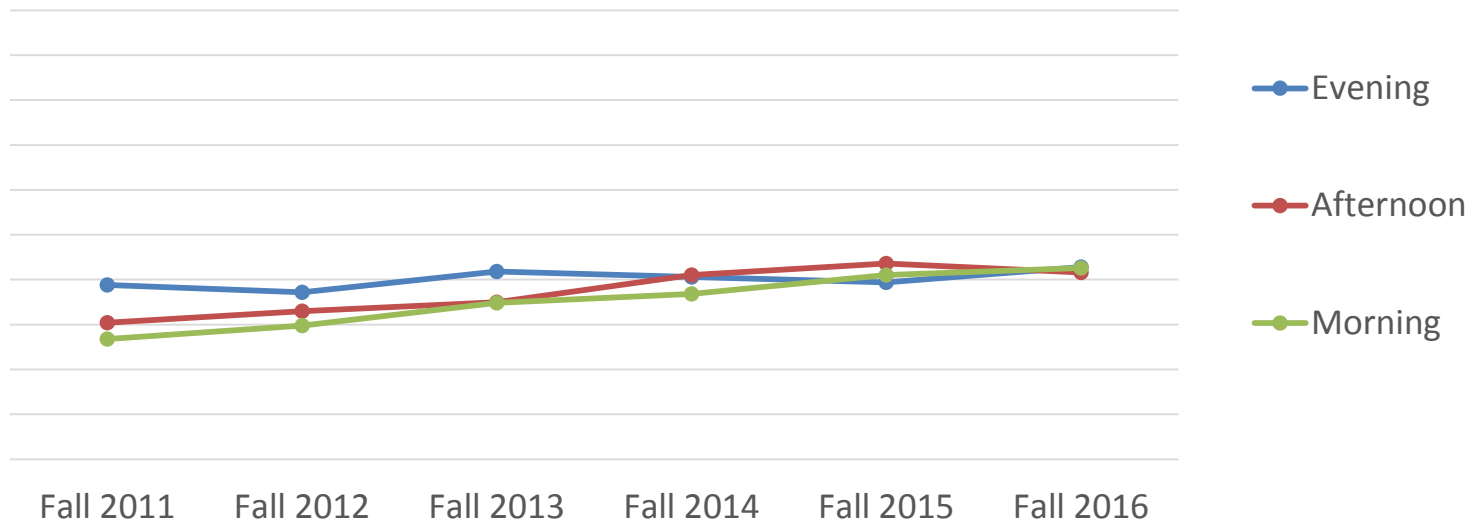


### Online Credit Hours (Percent of All Credit Hours)

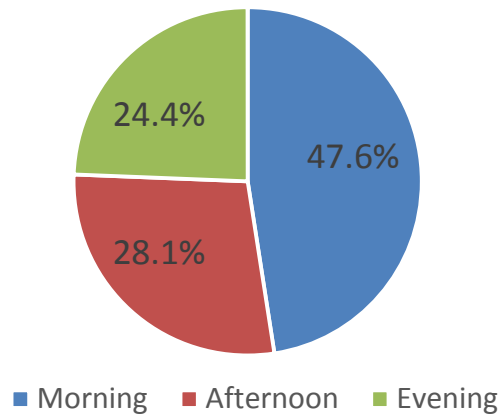

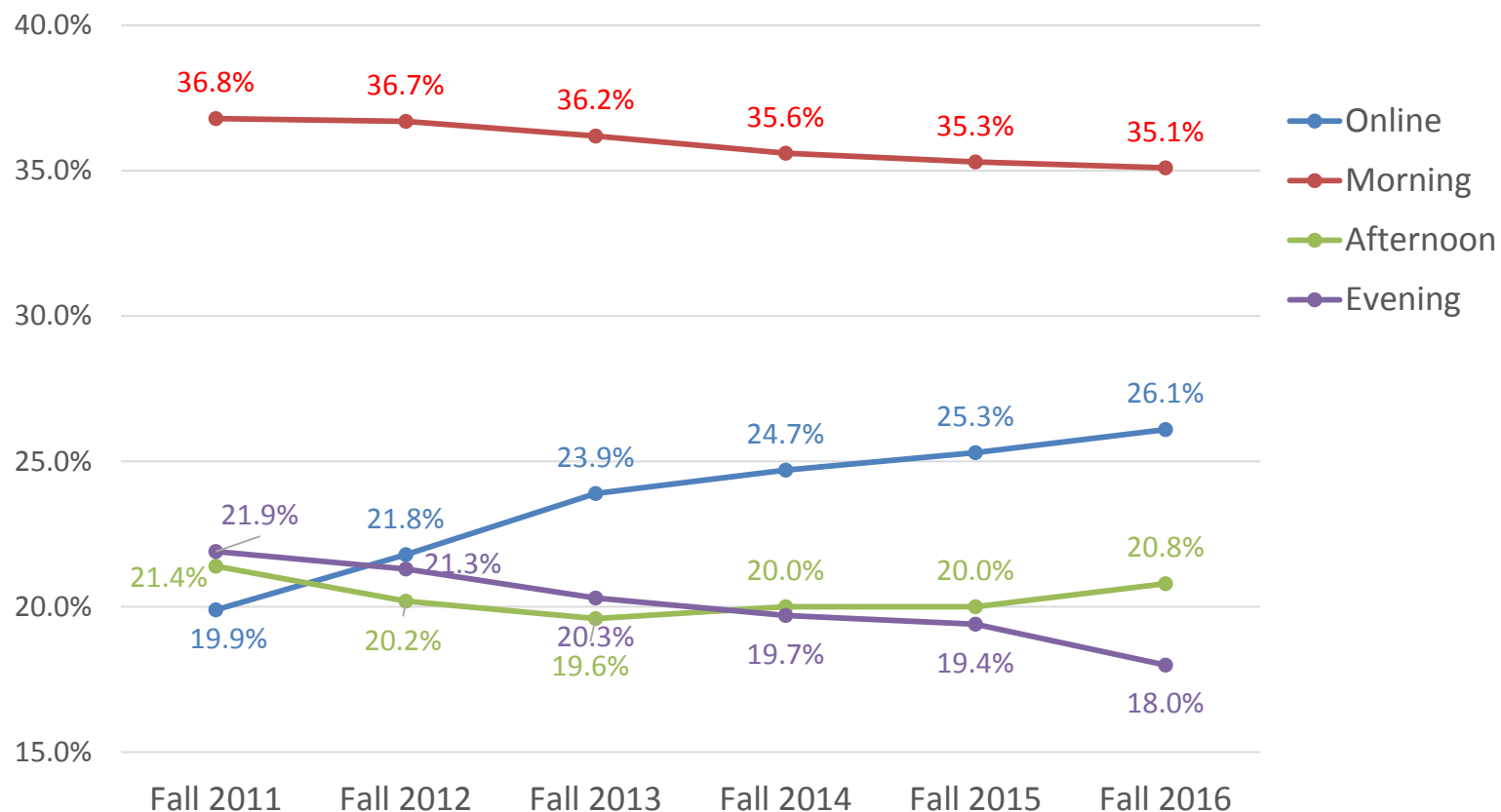
### Overall Fall Success Rates – By Time of Day



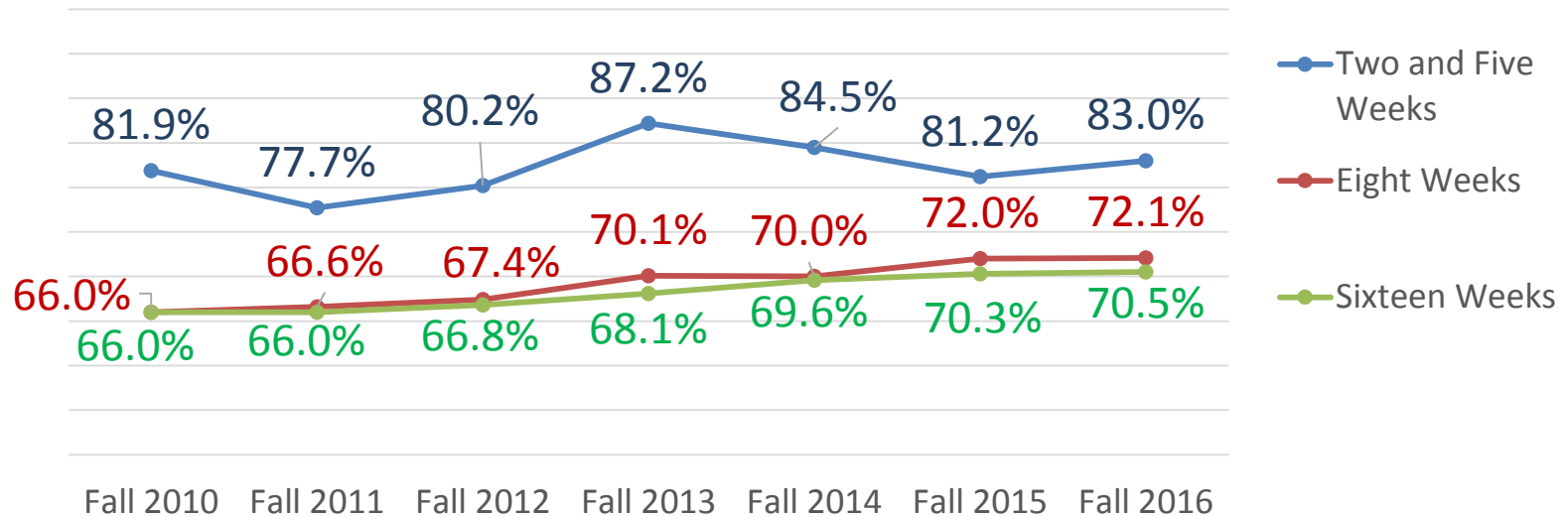
### Time of Day Enrollment Compositions – Fall 2016



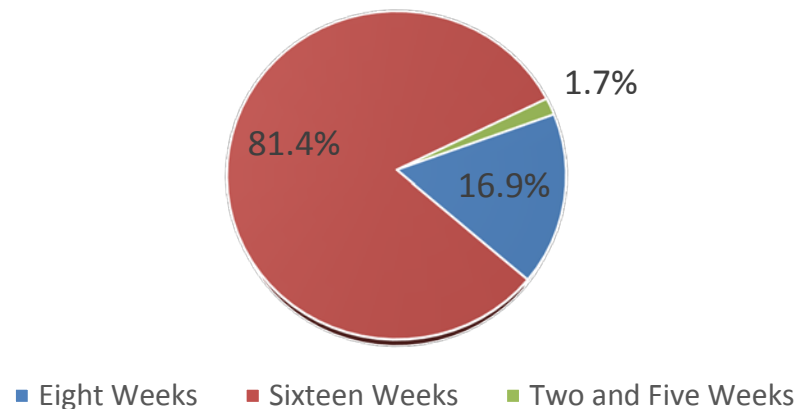
### Composition of Time of Day Enrollments Over Time



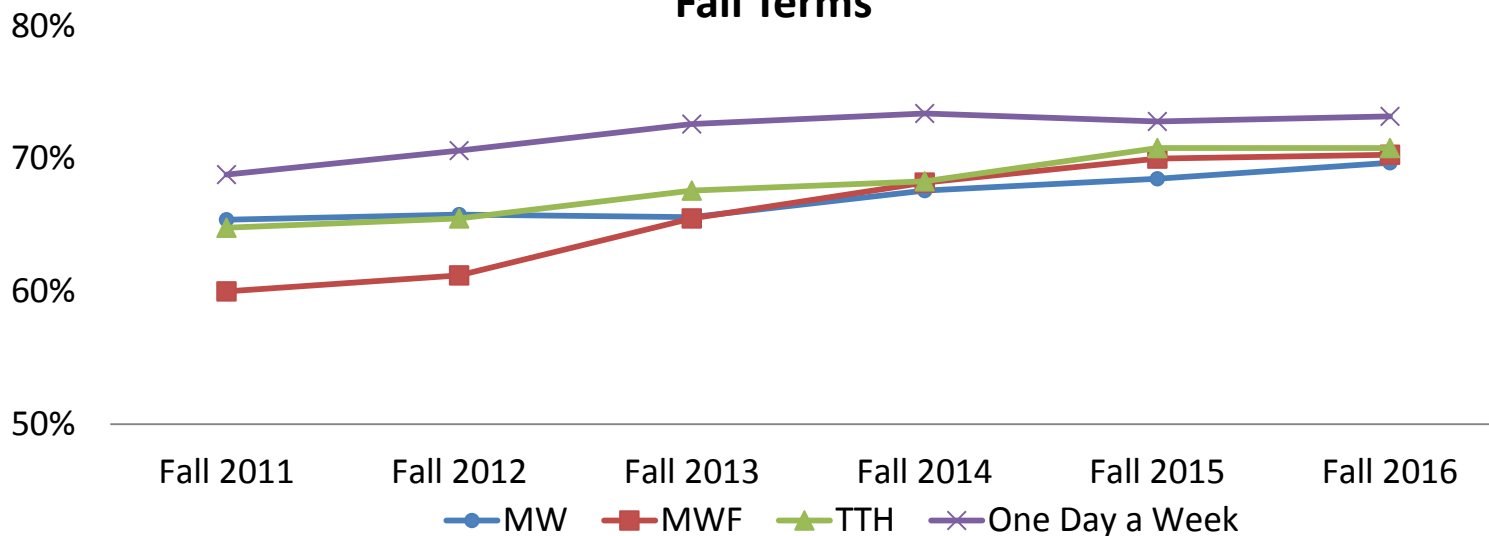

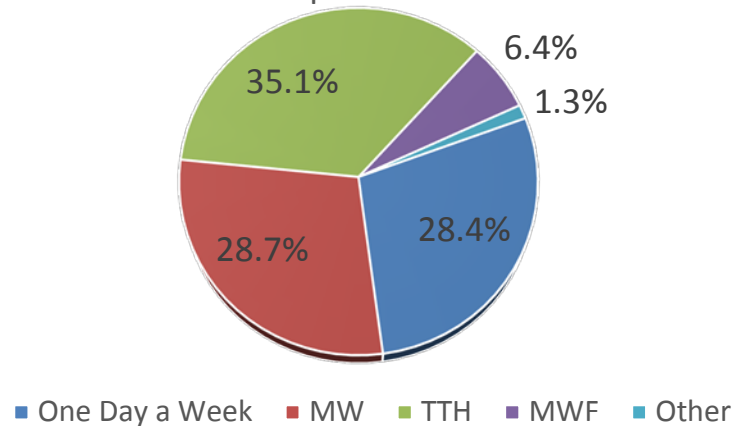
### Course Duration Enrollment Compositions – Fall 2016



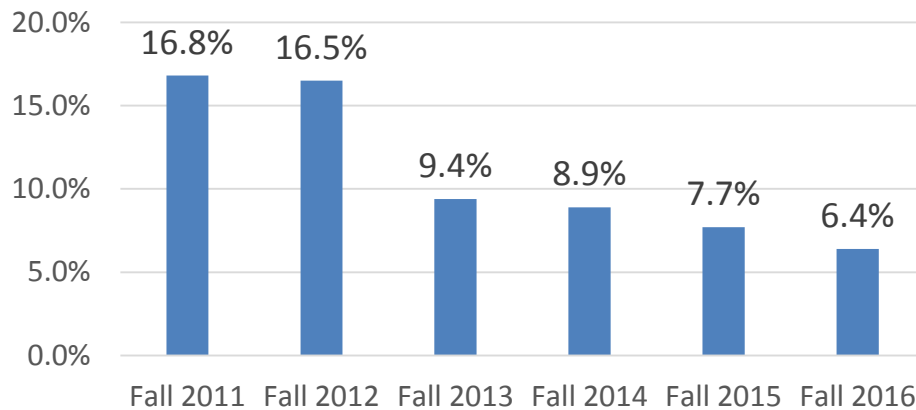
### Campus Success Rates by Days Each Week Fall Terms



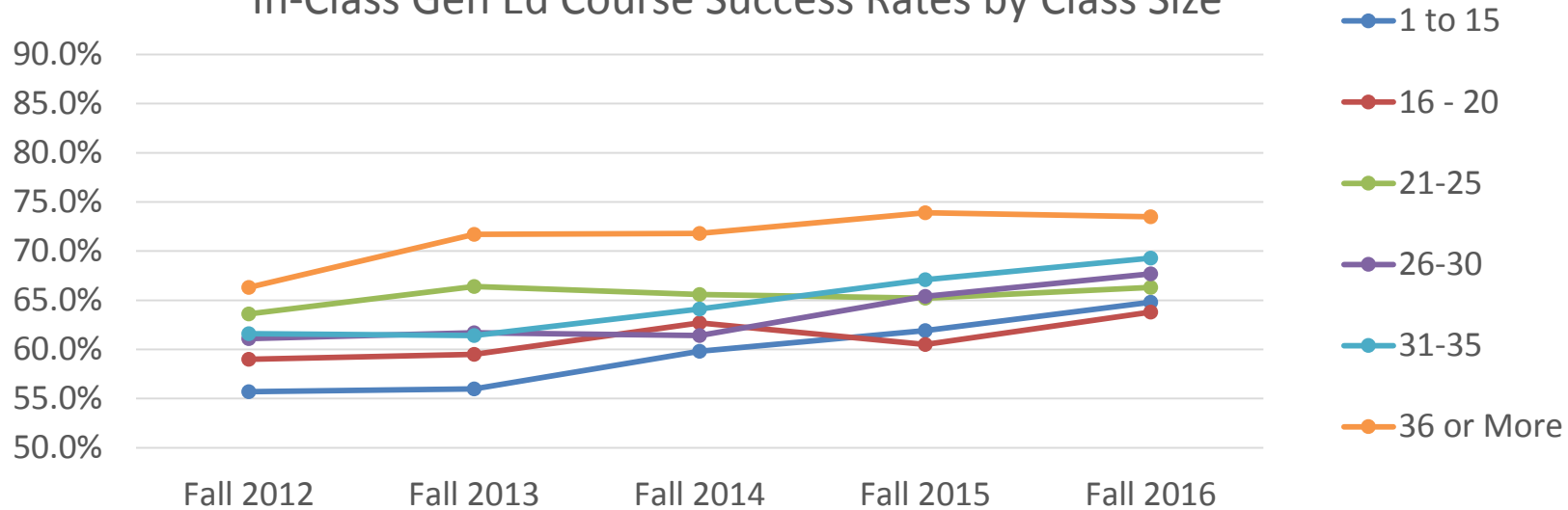
Course Day of the Week Offering Enrollment Compositions



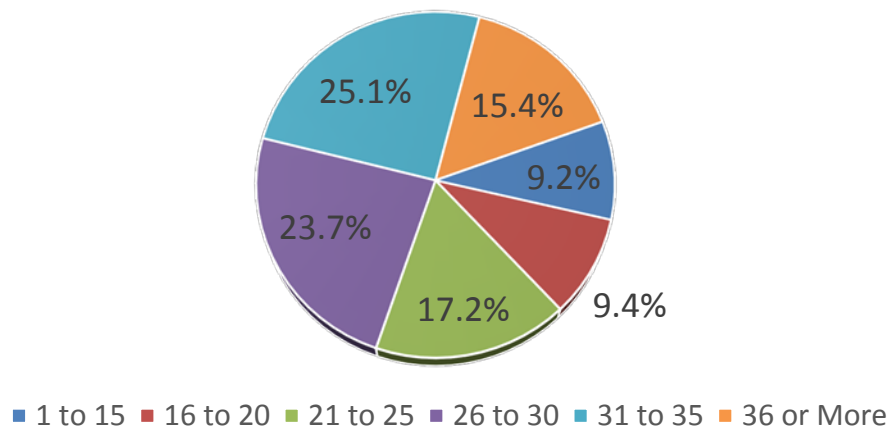
MWF Course Offering Composition Trend



In-Class Gen Ed Course Success Rates by Class Size



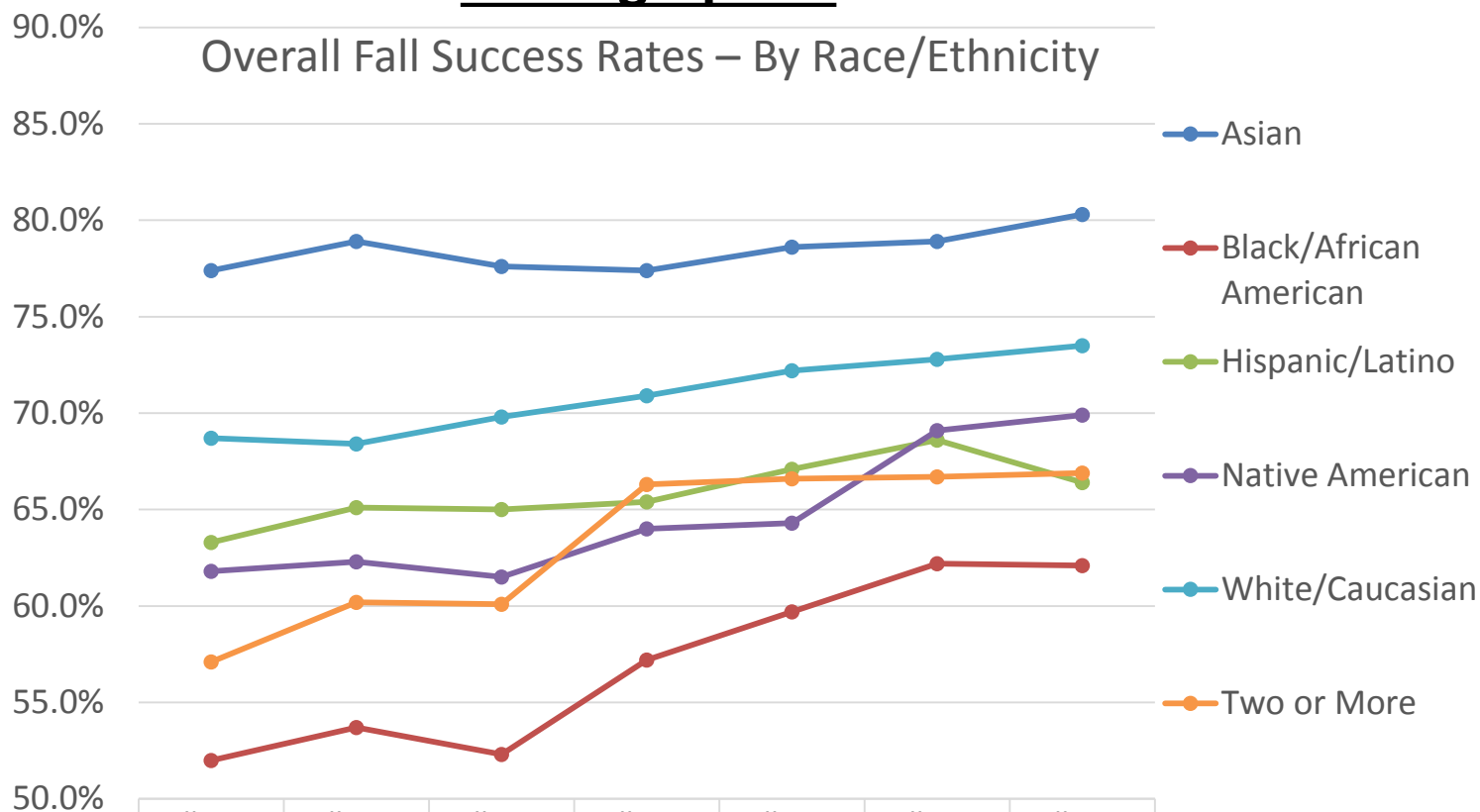
In-Class Gen Ed Class Size Compositions – Fall 2016





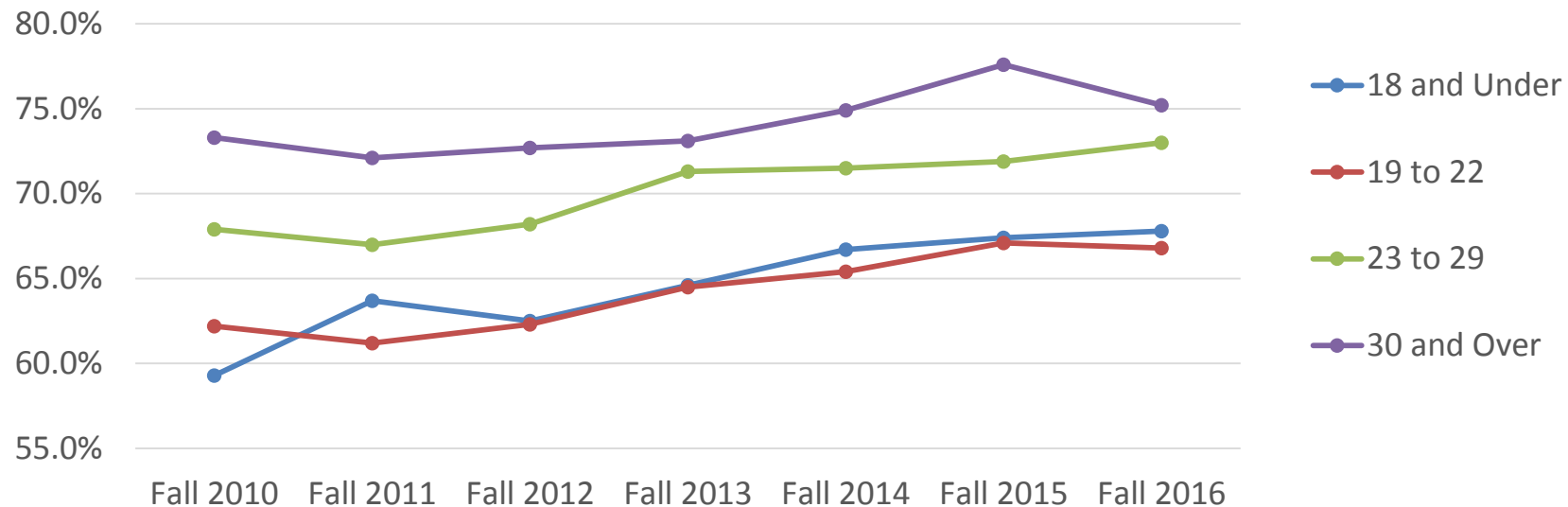

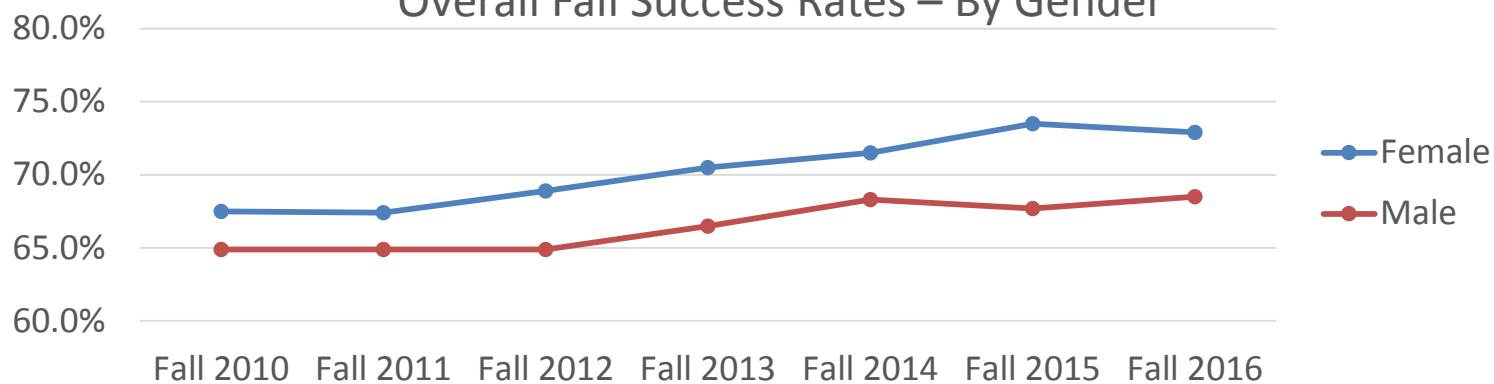

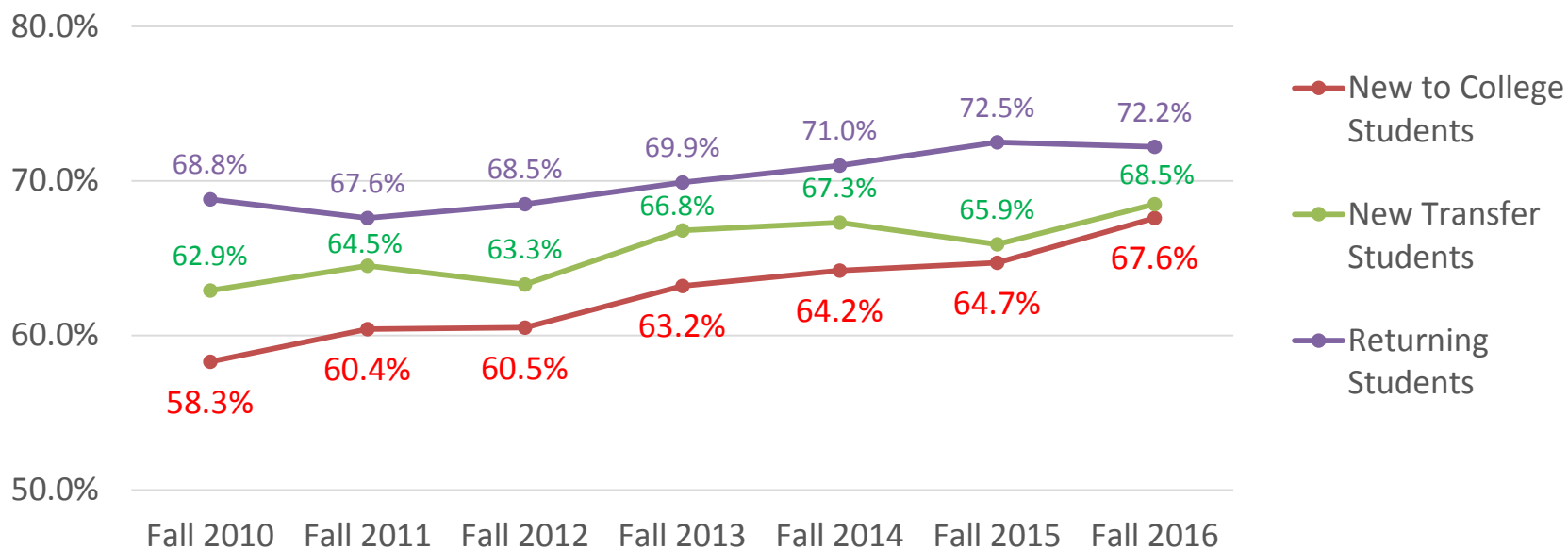
### Overall Fall Success Rates – By Age Groups (No Concurrents)



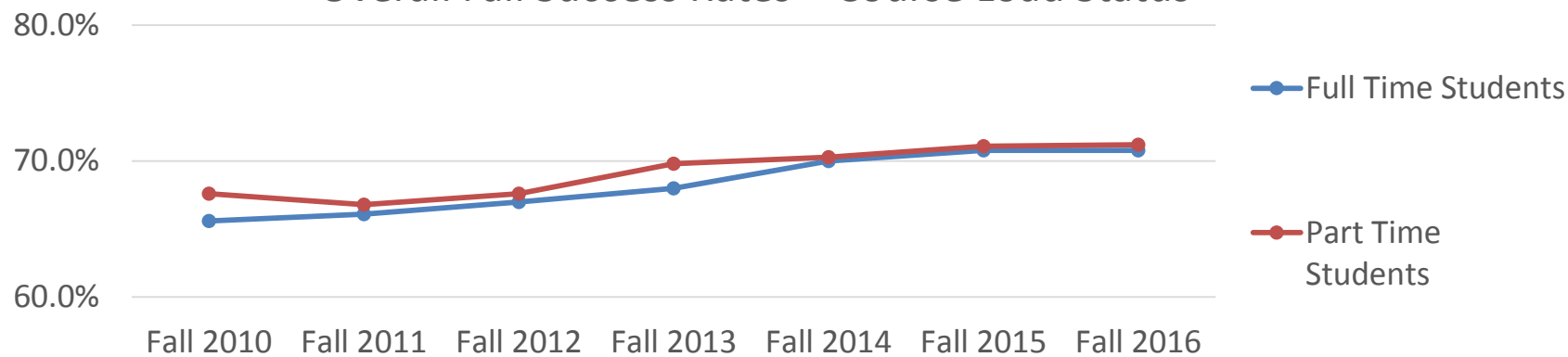
### Overall Fall Success Rates – By Gender



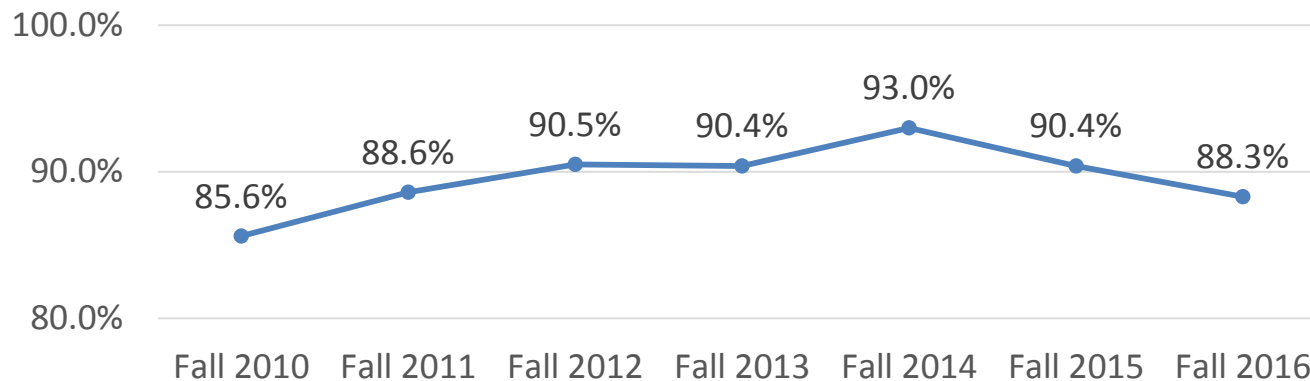
### Overall Fall Success Rates – By Student Type



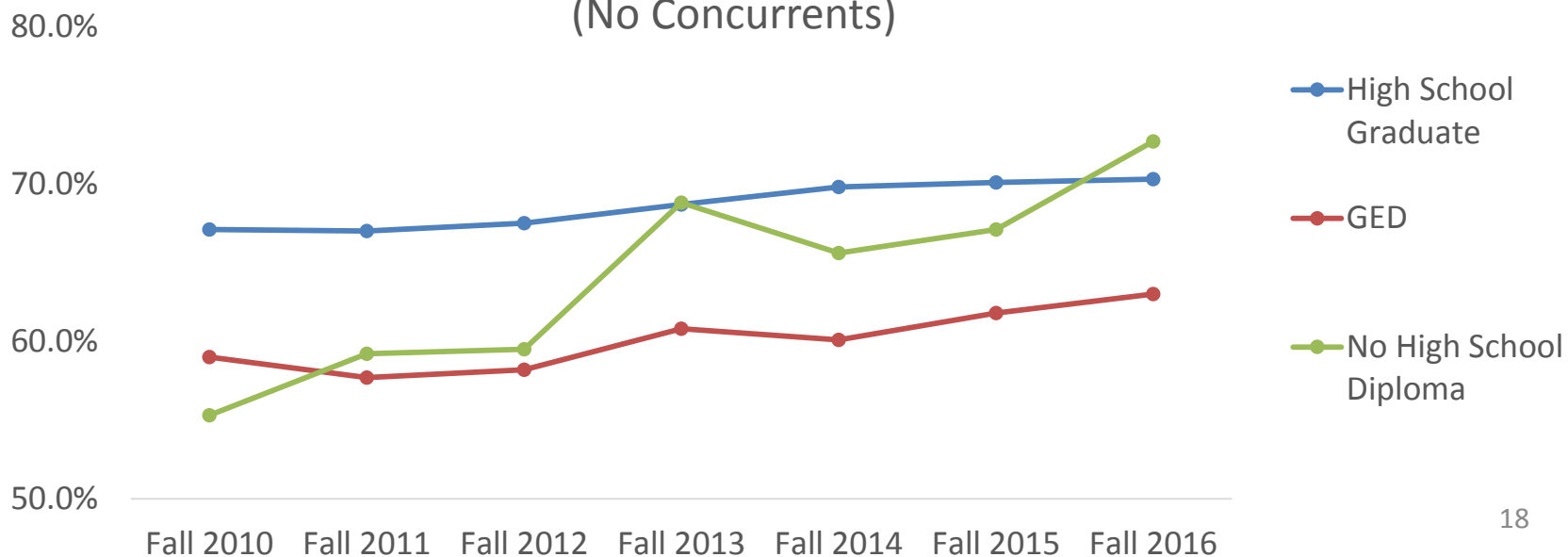
### Overall Fall Success Rates – Course Load Status



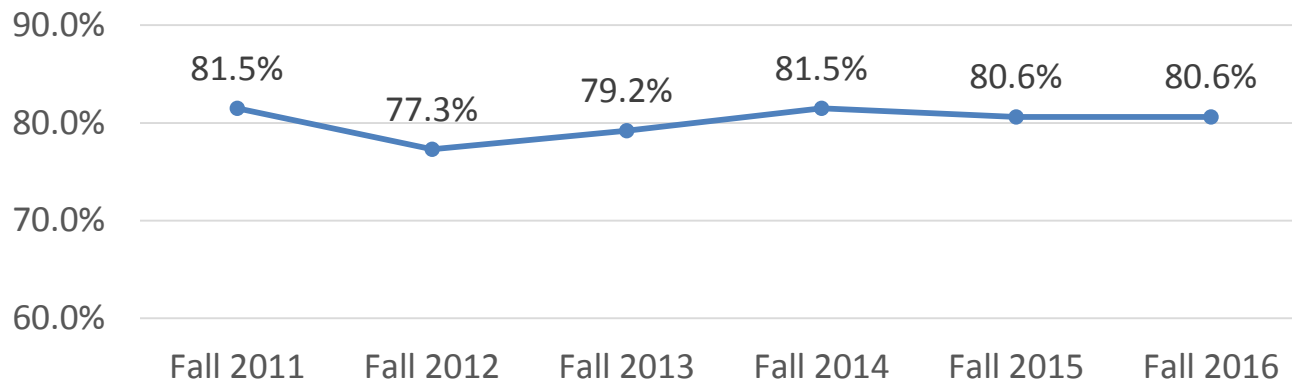

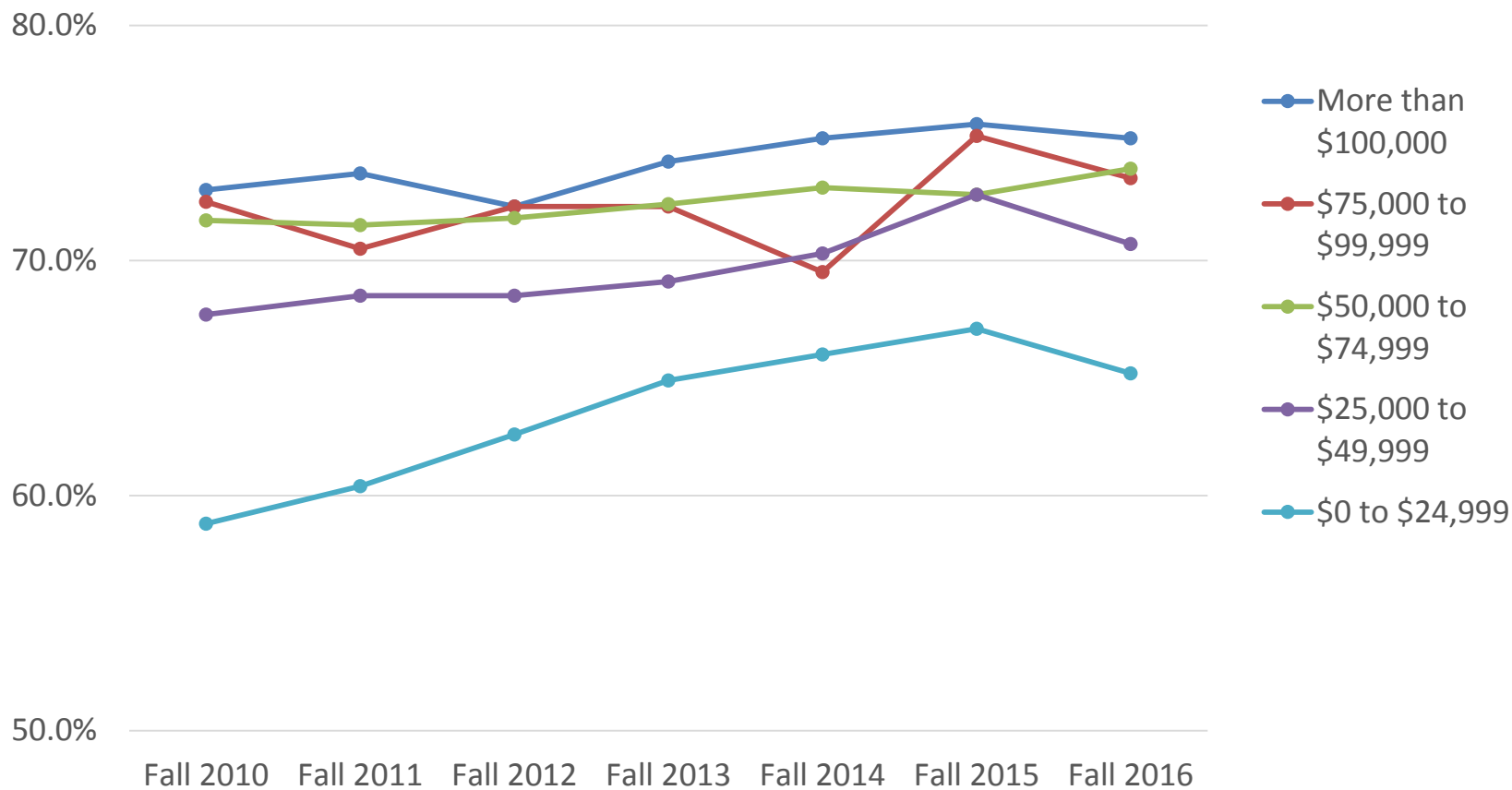
Overall Fall Success Rates – By High School Graduation Status (No Concurrents)

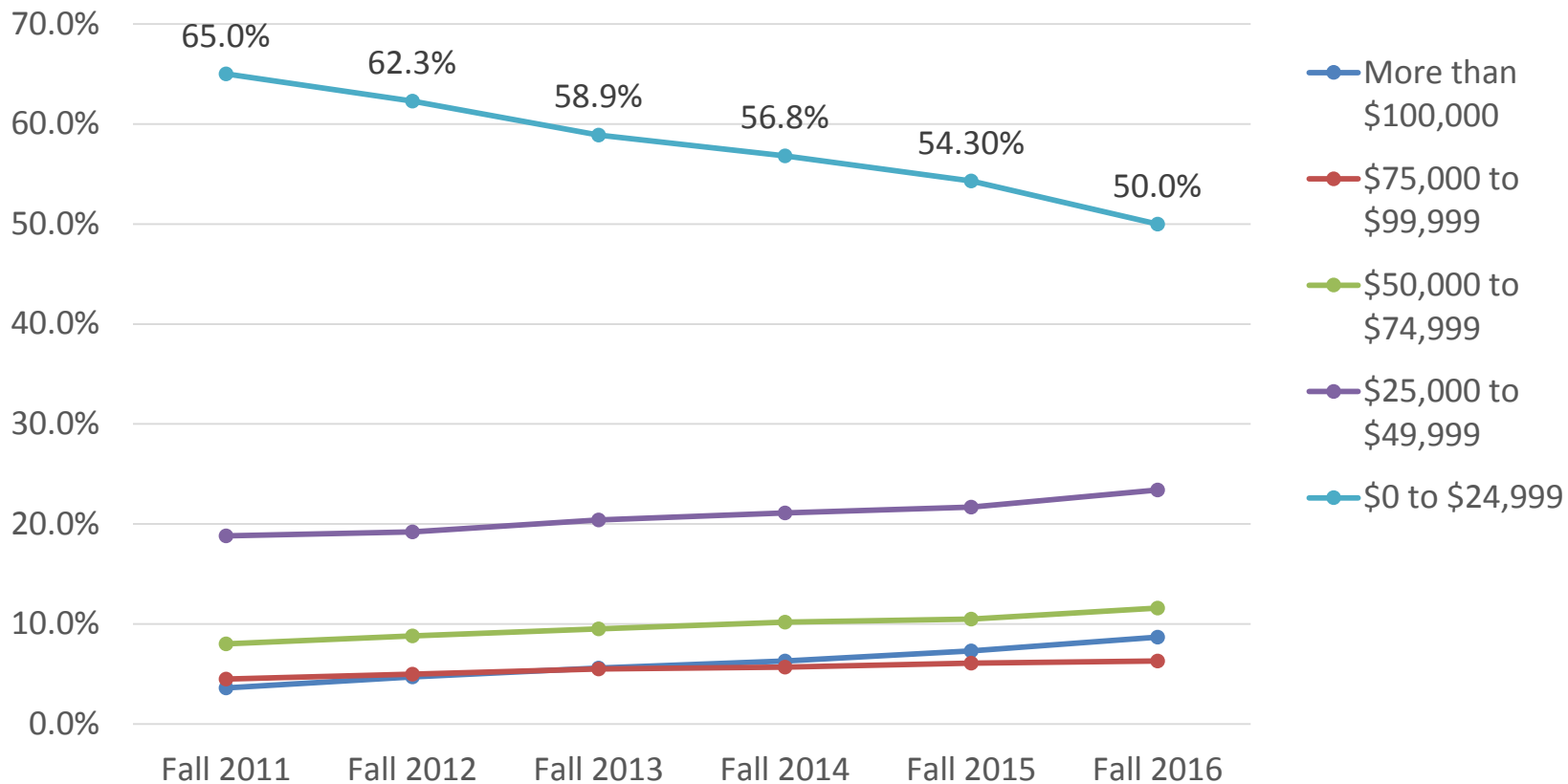


### Overall Fall Success Rates – By Family Income Categories (With FAFSA Information)

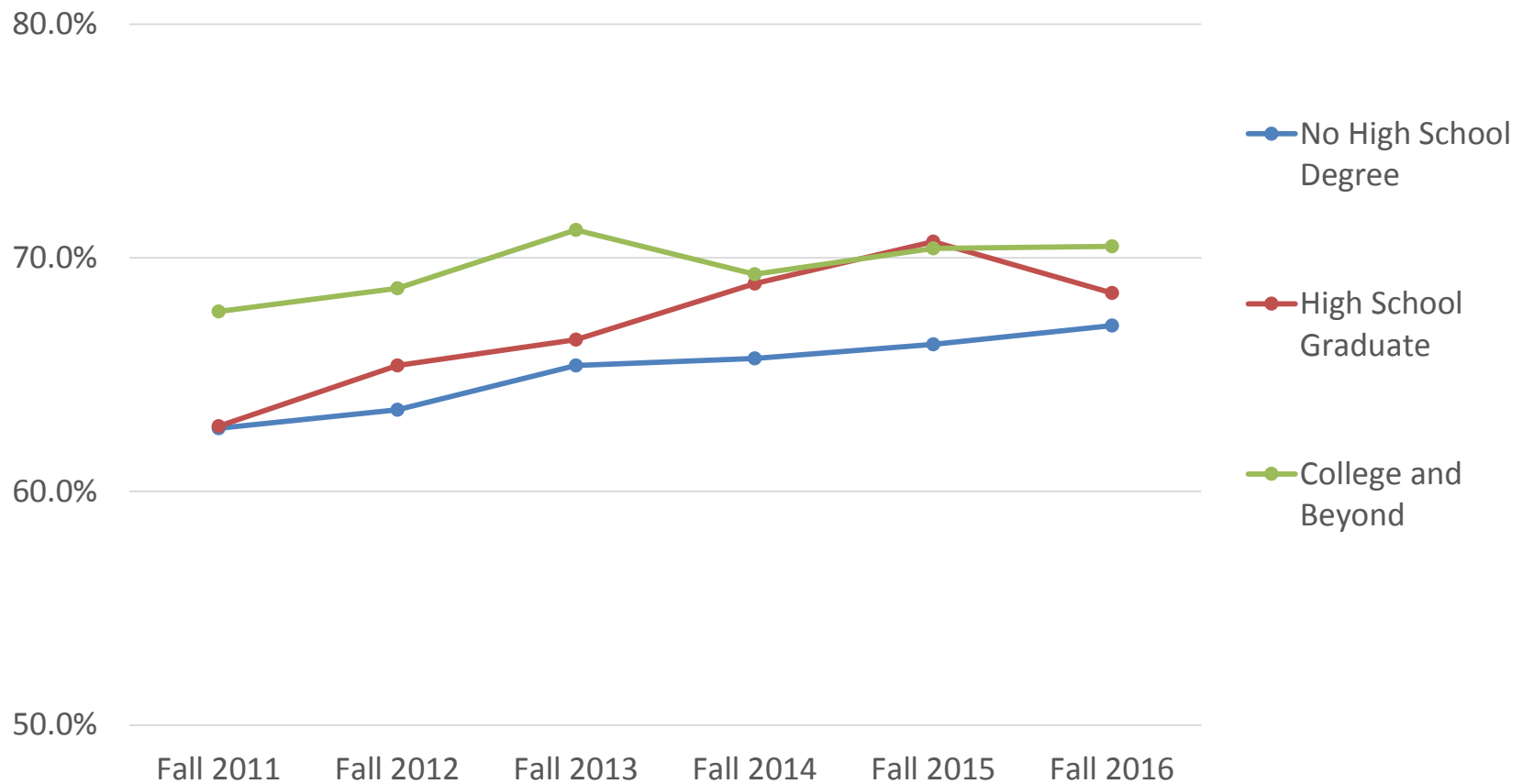




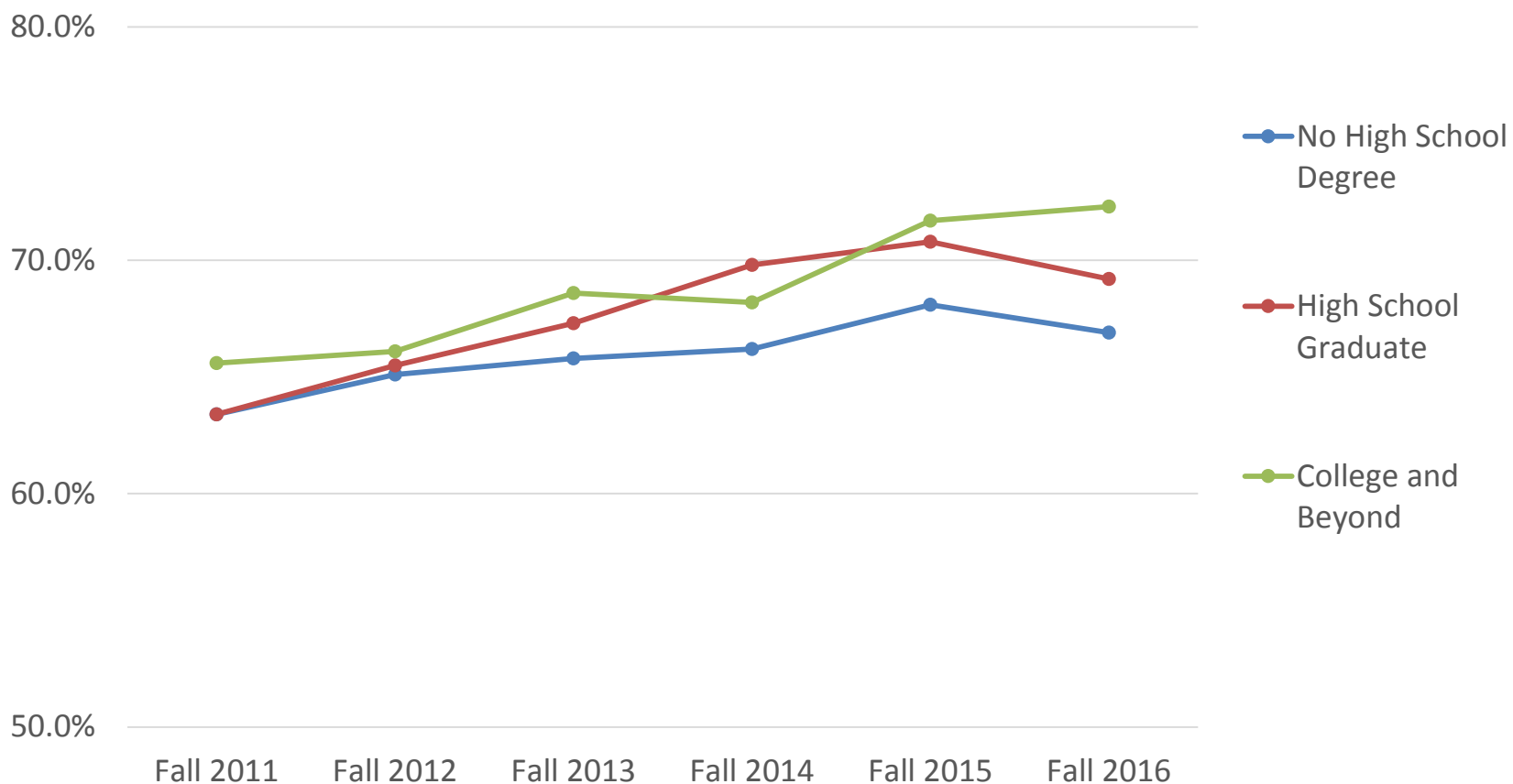
## Family Income Ranges Composition (With FAFSA Information)



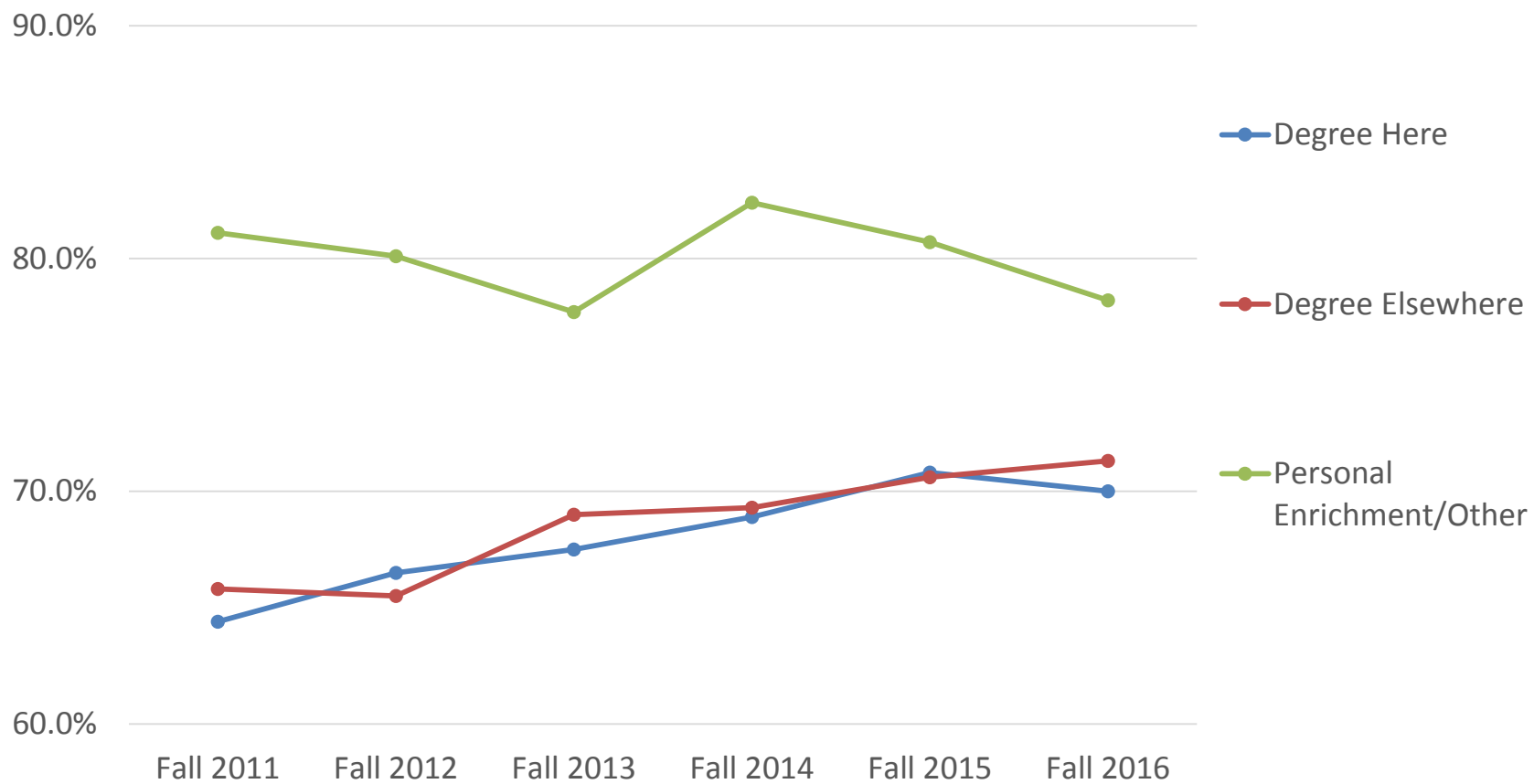

## Summary of Fall Success Report

- Overall campus success rates were essentially flat compared to last year.
- Online credit hours generated now represents more than a quarter of all credit. This has grown 48% since Fall 2010. With online growth, success gaps have narrowed.
- First time in college student success rates have increased 10 percentage points since fall 2010.
- There has been steady declines in both MWF course offerings and evening course offerings in last six fall terms.
- Largest declines in demographic related success rates were seen among Hispanics and students 30 and over.
