





Minimum Grade Requirements

1. Average in (a) all college course work, (b) course work at UCO, and (c) major courses.....2.50
2. A grade of "C" or better must be received in all major courses to count toward meeting these requirements.

Students must meet all bachelor degree requirements at UCO to include minimums of:

- 40 hours of upper division coursework
- 30 hours in residence at UCO
- 15 of the last 30 hours must be taken in residence at UCO
- 60 hours from baccalaureate granting institutions
