Transfer Agreement

Oklahoma City Community College (OCCC): Associate in Applied Science in Nursing (Traditional Pathway, Career Ladder Pathway, and Baccalaureate to Associate Degree Nurse Accelerated Pathway)

And

Oklahoma Christian University (OC): Online Pathways (CBE) for Bachelor of Science in Nursing

**Nurse Pathway Two:
OCCC Transfer Award***

OCCC graduates who bring an Associate in Applied Science Degree and Registered Nurse credentials into our Competency-Based-Education (CBE) program earn credits for knowledge gained on the job. OCCC graduates who are admitted to this program between July 2020 and May 2021 will be eligible for a 5% discount to an already competitive price -- often bringing the program to within a small amount of the eligible educational reimbursements available in area hospitals. Estimated total completion cost for OCCC graduates who receive this scholarship is \$11,400, a nationally and locally competitive price.

The completion of competencies linked to RN to BSN courses will result in an additional 28 hours of course credit for Nursing and 3 hours for Bible.

The transcripts of potential students will be reviewed to ensure that courses have been completed in the 7 areas of the OC core curriculum: communication, math, American citizenship, behavioral/social science, literature/fine arts, science, and global civilization. Any courses that are needed may be completed at OC, OCCC, and any other accredited college or university.

Based on transfer hours, students may need to take a Great Works course (3 hours) and/or a Liberal Arts course (3 hours) to fulfill their core curriculum requirements.

A total of 126 hours is required for completion of the BSN degree.

ADDITIONAL OC DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

Students are required to take 6-8 hours of Bible courses dependent upon the number of hours in the associate degree.
