Annual Report on Grants/ Donations

Summary:

- FY 2010 Annual Plan: Increase grants and donations over FY 2009 (which was \$3.8 million)
- As of January 11, 2010: 248 grants/gifts awarded for a total of \$3,206,242.
- Another \$9,692,788 in grants/donations is pending.
- By the end of FY2010, we anticipate the total of grants/donations to approach \$5 million, the highest in the institution's history.
