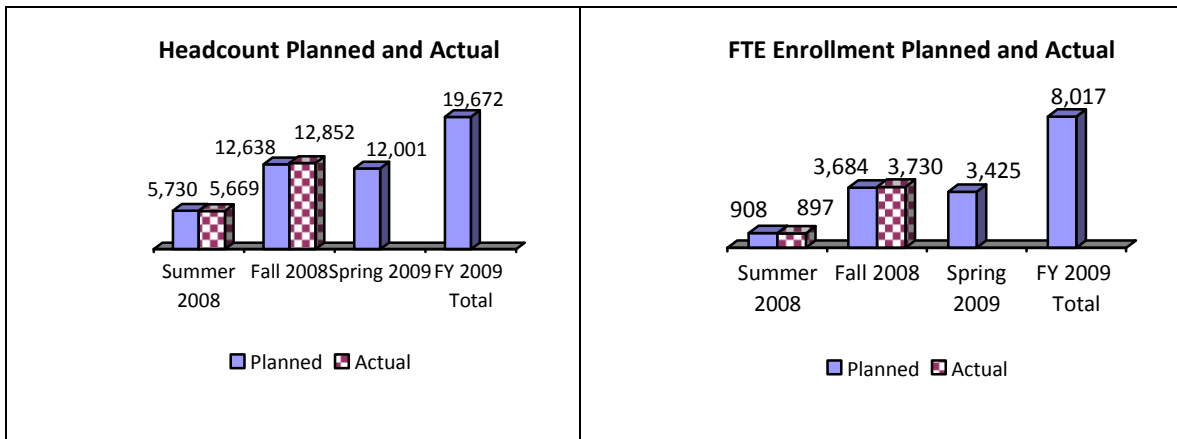
Report on 2008 Fall Enrollment and Student Demographics

**Introduction**

This incidental report provides both the academic and the demographic profile for the credit students enrolled at Oklahoma City Community College in Fall 2008, as of October 26, 2008.

**The FY 2009 Plan and Fall 2008 Enrollment Headcount and FTE**

The following charts were first presented at the October 20, 2008 Board of Regents meeting and are presented here as a reminder. Both the Headcount and FTE are above the planned enrollment for Fall 2008. (Headcount is up 1.7% while FTE is up 1.3%.)



**Academic Profile**

**Course Load-** Students are considered full time if they are enrolled in 12 credit hours or more.

- Part-time students make up 64% of the student body.
- Full-time students make up 36% of the students enrolled this fall.
- The average number of credit hours taken per student is 8.7 hours.

**New and Returning-** Thirty percent (30%) of the students are new to OCCC this fall, while 70% are returning students.

**ACT Scores-** Although not a criterion for admission, almost 33% of the students attending this fall have an ACT score on file. Of those students for whom there is an ACT score, the average score is 19.9.

**Class Type-** Seventy-three percent (73%) of the students are enrolled in traditional course only. However, 17% of the students are enrolled in at least one online class and are also enrolled in at least one traditional course. Ten percent (10%) are enrolled exclusively in online classes.

## **Demographic Profile**

**Gender-** Female students make up 58% of the total student body while male students constitute 42%.

**Age-** The average age of the student body is 26.1 years. The median age is 23 years. The distribution of age groups is as follows:

- 17 and under 3%
- 18 to 22 45%
- 23 to 30 30%
- 31 and over 22%

**Ethnicity-** The student body reflects the ethnic distribution of the five county area surrounding the College with a third of the students self reporting membership in the following categories:

- African American – 10 %
- Asian – 7 %
- Hawaiian/Pacific Islanders – 1 %
- Hispanic/Latino – 9 %
- Native American – 6%
- White/Caucasian – 61%
- Other/unknown – 6%

**Socioeconomics-** As a result of filing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), almost 5,700 students, or 44% of the students enrolled, have been awarded Federal Title IV financial aid for the academic year. The average Estimated Family Contribution (EFC) for an awarded student is \$5,725.

Of the students enrolled and awarded aid, 3,698 or 29% are Pell eligible based upon an EFC less than \$4,041. The average EFC for Pell eligible students at OCCC is \$776.00.

**First Generation-** First generation students are defined by the Department of Education as neither parent having attended college. Currently, the methodology for determining the number of first generation students is reliant on the data gathered from the students who completed the FAFSA.

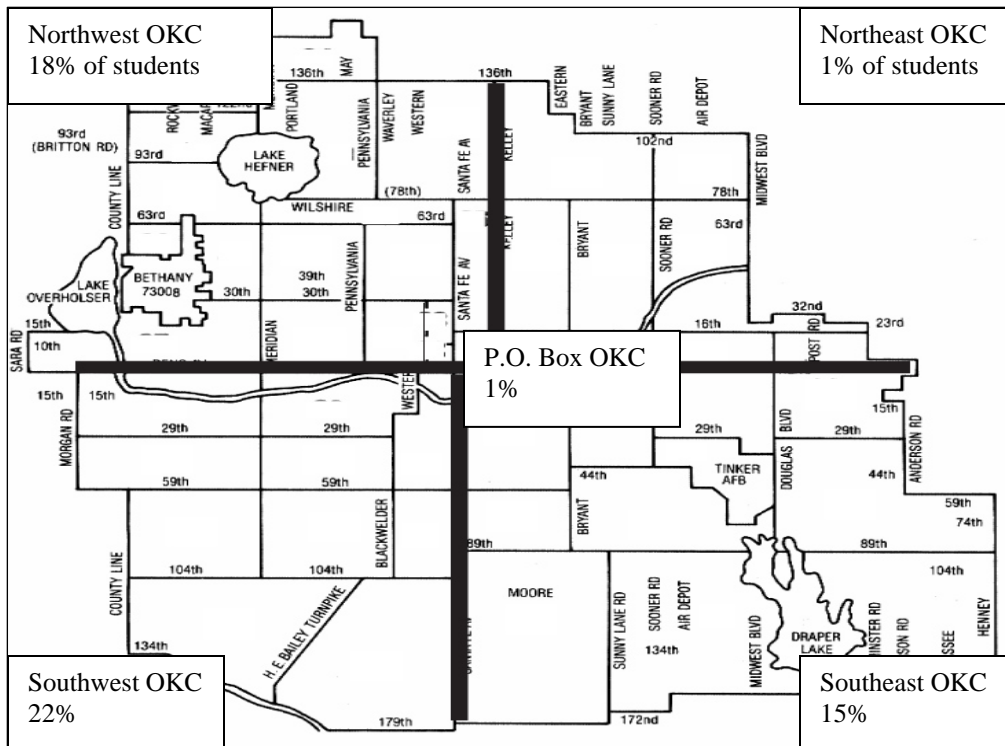
The distribution of 8,085 FAFSA completers by parental education is as follows:

- Neither parent attended college 56%
- Mother attended college 17%
- Father attended college 11%
- Both parents attended college 15%

**Place of Residence-** Of the entire student body, 57% have a 731 XXXX zip code area within Oklahoma City or Moore

- 22% reside in the Southwest Metro Area
- 18% reside in the Northwest Metro Area
- 15% reside in the Southeast Metro Area
- 1% resides in the Northeast Metro Area
- An additional 1% maintains an Oklahoma City P.O. Box.

**International Students-** There are 445 students, from 58 countries, enrolled in classes at OCCC this fall. The top ten countries represented at OCCC are the same as last Fall, they are:

**Fall 2008 Enrollment and Student Demographics of  
New OKC Go Participants**

With the relaunch and expansion of OKC Go, there was a 42% increase in the number of new students participating in the program this fall. The following enrollment and demographic information is provided on the 366 new OKC Go students enrolled this fall.

**Course Load –**

77% are enrolled full-time; with an average credit hour load of 13  
23% are enrolled part-time; with an average credit hour load of 8

**Course Placement –**

40% tested into Developmental Reading  
48% tested into Developmental Writing  
71% tested into Developmental Math

**Gender –**

60 % Female  
40 % Male

30% Hispanic  
27% African American  
26% White/ Caucasian  
6% Asian  
6% Other/Unknown  
5% Native America  
.2% Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander

**Socioeconomic –**

93% completed the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).  
(Last year, 53% of the new OKC Go participants filed a FAFSA.)  
62% are Pell grant eligible based upon an EFC of less than \$4,041.

For the schools from which data was reported, there were 1,733 graduates. Twenty percent (20%) are enrolled at OCCC and are part of OKC Go.
