"Surveillance, Terrorism and Civil Liberties" a special lecture by Roger Newman

Thursday, March 6 – 2 p.m. – CU3

Roger K. Newman, an award-winning author and media and civil liberties scholar, will speak on "Surveillance, Terrorism and the Constitution" and will discuss constitutional liberties. Newman received master's degrees from the University of Virginia and New York University. Newman has taught at Columbia University Graduate School of Journalism in addition to a 16-year tenure at the New York University as a research scholar.

Born and reared in Duncan, Oklahoma, Jari Askins was sworn in as Oklahoma's 15th Lieutenant Governor in 2007 Askins was elected to the Oklahoma House of Representatives in 1994 from District 50, and served for twelve years, earning the position of Democratic House Leader in 2005. She won statewide election as Lieutenant Governor in 2006, becoming the first Democratic woman to serve in that office.
