Enrollment: If you want to start now, I've listed information below with various details, and a schedule of paying for the trip ahead of time. If you want to earn three credit hours in Humanities too, you'll have to enroll in the special topics course offered and which should appear in either the Fall 07 or Spring 08 course schedule. You would be responsible for all tuition and related fees for that as well as travel expenses as explained below and on the website. Be sure to use the number below to access the correct tour group. You have three ways to enroll into the tour group as listed below, whichever way you're comfortable doing. I've included information about paying on a schedule as well as a link for an automatic payment program (Autopay).

Your **tour ID # 935695** will enable your participants to enroll immediately online at www.eftours.com/student with a credit or debit card payment of \$95 for the lifetime membership fee.
