- Tuition and fees for three credit hours of Spanish. (Additional fees may be charged for first-time or non-resident students.)
- Airfare to and from Oklahoma City to Oaxaca, ground transportation and excursions in Mexico.
- Hotel lodging in Oaxaca City and Huatulco, and two meals a day.

TO ENROLL:

- Complete and detach the form below and take it to the Arts & Humanities Division office, 1E3-AH, where you will pick up the deposit payment form. The office is open from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday-Friday.
- Pay the \$200 non-refundable deposit in the Bursar's Office by March 26, 2003.
- Pay the remaining cost in two payments: \$895 by May 2, 2003, and \$1000 by June 13, 2003. Pick up a fee payment form from the Arts & Humanities Division office and make the payment in the Bursar's Office. After making your payment in the Bursar's Office, PLEASE BRING YOUR RECEIPT TO THE ARTS & HUMANITIES DIVISION OFFICE SO A COPY CAN BE MADE FOR OUR FILES.
