Join us for an immersion experience, without leaving the country! This one-credit-hour class with Profesora Patricia Jiménez Brooks provides a unique opportunity for students with some Spanish experience to develop their listening and speaking skills.

Students will interact with instructors and native-speaker volunteers as they engage in a variety of activities including storytelling, plays, films, games, singing, dancing, and nature walks--all in Spanish!

The class will meet on the OCCC campus Thursday, November 13, 2008. The Immersion Weekend at Canyon Camp and Retreat Center takes place November 14-16. Additional \$150 fee for lodging and activities.

ENROLLMENT PROCESS

The enrollment process involves three steps:

- (1) Enroll in the course online or in person.

If you have had Spanish 1013 or 1115, or both, you should enroll in SPAN 1151.

If you have had Spanish 1123 or 1225, or any Spanish class at the 2000 level, you should enroll in SPAN 2051.

If you have not completed the prerequisite course(s), you must be evaluated by Modern Language faculty to determine the appropriate level for you. It will be necessary to enroll in person, with an enrollment form signed by faculty.

- (2) Pay your tuition and fees (\$84.00) in the Bursar's Office.
- (3) Pick up a fee payment form in the Arts and Humanities Division office and pay the remaining \$150 fee (covers five meals, snacks, two nights' lodging, and activities) in the Bursar's Office by October 31, 2008.

There is *ONE* class meeting on campus:

Thursday, November 13, 2008, 6:00-7:30 p.m. (Room to be announced)

At this meeting, you will receive an orientation, as well as maps and driving directions. There will be a limited number of college vans to provide transportation for those who do not wish to drive to the Canyon Camp and Retreat Center.
