Spend nine days and eight nights discovering the rich cultural heritage of Mexico. Students will arrive in Mexico City and travel by bus to Puebla, a beautiful colonial city located about 80 miles southeast of the capital. Puebla is the fourth largest city in Mexico and is rich in history and culture. Lodging will be at the Hotel Colonial, located in the historical center of the city. This hotel has served American colleges and universities for more than 35 years, and its friendly staff is familiar with the needs of American students.

Acompañantes, knowledgeable residents of Puebla, will work with OKCCC students for an hour and half each day in Puebla. Students will spend much of that time in Spanish conversation as they explore the city's history and culture. Students will tour Puebla's museums, colonial buildings, and artist colony. Group excursions to nearby archaeological sites in Cholula and Cacaxtla and to the lovely city of Tlaxcala are planned.

An overnight excursion to Mexico City will include visits to the pyramids of Teotihuacan, the Museum of Anthropology, the Plaza Mayor, the Basilica of Guadalupe, the Ballet Folklórico, and other sites as time permits.

SPANISH IN MEXICO 2004 STUDENTS:

The total cost for this 8-night, 9-day language and cultural experience is \$1595. The course begins Saturday, July 24, 2004, and ends Sunday, August 1, 2004.

INCLUDED FOR \$1595:

- Tuition and fees for three credit hours of Spanish. (Additional fees may be charged for first-time or non-resident students.)
- Airfare to and from Oklahoma City to Mexico City, ground transportation to and from Puebla, and excursions in Mexico.
- Hotel lodging in Puebla and Mexico City, and most meals.

TO ENROLL:

- Complete and detach the form below and take it to the Arts & Humanities Division office, 1E3-AH, where you will pick up the deposit payment form. The office is open from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday-Friday.
- Pay the \$200 **non-refundable** deposit in the Bursar's Office by March 24, 2004.
- Pay the remaining cost in two payments: \$700 by May 5, 2004, and \$695 by June 9, 2004. Pick up a fee payment form from the Arts & Humanities Division office and make the payment in the Bursar's Office. After making your payment in the Bursar's Office, **PLEASE BRING YOUR RECEIPT TO THE ARTS & HUMANITIES DIVISION OFFICE SO A COPY CAN BE MADE FOR OUR FILES.**
