**SPANISH IN SPAIN 2001 STUDENTS:**

**The total cost for this 12-day language and cultural experience is \$2300.  
The course begins Friday, May 18, 2001, and ends Tuesday, May 29, 2001.**

**INCLUDED FOR \$2300:**

- Tuition and fees for three credit hours of Spanish. (Additional fees may be charged for first-time or non-resident students.)
- Round-trip airfare from Oklahoma City to Spain (arriving in Madrid, returning from Málaga), ground transportation while in Spain, including a four-day excursion to Southern Spain.
- Hotel lodging and two meals a day.
- Entrance fees to museums and historical sites.

- Complete and detach the form below and take it to the Arts & Humanities Division office, 1E3-AH, where you will pick up the deposit payment form. The office is open from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday-Friday.
- Pay the **\$250 non-refundable** deposit in the Student Store by:  
**January 28, 2001.**
- Pay the remaining cost of **\$2050** by:  
**March 19, 2001.**
