

ADA Support Committee
Recommendation
May 17, 2000

On April 4, 2000 a report was received concerning the approved ADA assessment of Oklahoma City Community College that was conducted on February 9, 2000. The full report is enclosed.

The report's summary commends the College for its commitment to "assure the best possible, educational experience for persons with disabilities" and notes "OCCC appears to have been involved in an on going effort to assure the students with disabilities access to their facilities, programs and educational experiences."

The ADA Support Committee proposes that the College follow the recommendations contained within the report. Estimated costs for the recommendations are as follows:
