#### **Committee Reports** – Angel Migration Presentation – Bertha Wise

Bertha Wise gave a demonstration of the two content designs created for ANGEL, the new online learning management system: Page Design and Icon Design. Because it's been shown in research that having one design for all courses raises the rates of student retention and student success, it's important that we make a choice as to which design we should use in Arts and Humanities online courses. Of the two designs, the one that Bertha is using is the page design as that has been shown also to be more effective since students spend less time trying to learn how to navigate and find assignments than if they had the icon design. It is also somewhat easier to edit, when needed, from the teacher/designer's perspective. The general consensus seemed to indicate favor for the page design by those who expressed an opinion.
