Dr. Schwark opened the meeting by inviting Gary Tucker to talk about enrollment information and data.

Gary Tucker shared information gathered by him and Lisa Adkins in the process of applying for the Oklahoma Quality Award for Excellence.

Dr. Schwark welcomed Vince Orza, Interim Dean of OCU's Meinders School of Business.

Dr. Orza spoke about the benefits of transferring to OCU.

Dr. Schwark said that there would be some curriculum changes to the Automotive and Medical Transcription programs taken to Curriculum Committee. Dr. Schwark spoke about the changes coming due to the new branding campaign. He said that these changes would affect e-mail, business cards (to be ordered at the end of June), stationary and envelopes. There will also be an electronic sign added at the corner of 74th and May Avenue.

Dr. Schwark indicated that it shouldn't be a problem, and that we would look into those changes.

Dr. Schwark reminded faculty of the "Next Steps" Technology Brown Bag Sessions being held February 9 & 16 from 12:30 - 1:30, and encouraged them to attend.

Dr. Schwark mentioned encouraging graduation, saying that we may have students that are 1 or 2 classes away from a degree that have never applied for graduation.
