#### DISCUSSION:

LATE REGISTRATION/INCOMPLETES/GRADE CHANGES: DR. TABOR REMINDED EVERYONE THAT STUDENTS NEED TO HAVE ASSIGNMENTS COMPLETED BY THE END OF THE SEMESTER. IF ALL ASSIGNMENTS HAVE NOT BEEN SUBMITTED, IT IS UP TO THE INSTRUCTOR TO SUBMIT EITHER AN "F" OR AN "I" FOR INCOMPLETE, IN WHICH CASE THE STUDENT NEEDS TO HAVE ALL COURSEWORK COMPLETED BY A CERTAIN DATE DETERMINED BY THE INSTRUCTOR.

IRB and Classroom Assignments: For any assignments which require students to interview other individuals please be sure they know they cannot interview anyone under 18 years of age and/or any students enrolled in the Pathways program.

SCHEDULING/SPRING ONLINE CLASSES: FOR THE SPRING ONLINE SECTIONS, DR. TABOR ASKS THAT FULL-TIME FACULTY LIMIT THEMSELVES TO NO MORE THAN THREE ONLINE SECTIONS AS PART OF YOUR FULL-TIME WORKLOAD OF FIVE SECTIONS.
