Bill and Carol Sechrist Endowed Scholarship Fund

Oklahoma City Community College President Paul Sechrist established an endowed scholarship fund in honor of his parents, Bill and Carol Sechrist. The fund will support students' participation in travel-enhanced classes sponsored by OCCC academic divisions. The scholarship award is to be used toward a for-credit travel-enhanced course from Oklahoma City Community College in the 2010 academic year.

Application Procedures

Pick up a scholarship application at the Institutional Advancement Office or from the Faculty member coordinating the travel-enhanced course.

To be considered valid, your college transcript must include grades from the most recent semester in which you attended classes.

The deadline for scholarship applications to be submitted is 5:00 p.m., February 5, 2010, to the Institutional Advancement Office or to the Faculty member coordinating the travel-enhanced class program.

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to apply for the Bill and Carol Sechrist Endowed Scholarship Fund, applicants should meet the following criteria:

1. Student must have completed at least 24 credit hours with a 3.0 GPA.
2. Student must submit a one-page essay telling why he/she wants to take a travel-enhanced course and how he/she thinks this will benefit him/her.
3. Student will be asked whether he/she is receiving financial aid (or to indicate financial need in some way).
4. Student must provide two faculty recommendations.
5. Students who receive this award will be asked to make a presentation after they complete their travel-study course.
6. Funds are to be used ONLY for OCCC travel-enhanced courses, and students must be enrolled for credit in the course.

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to apply for the Jean and Ralph Gamel Scholarship, applicants should meet the following criteria:

1. have the need for financial assistance to attend Oklahoma City Community College
2. have minimum grade point average of 2.0
3. be committed to completing an Associate Degree at Oklahoma City Community College

Selection Procedure

The recipient will be selected by the Scholarship Selection Committee. The amount is up to \$1,000 per semester for tuition, fees, and books. Disbursement for the second semester is contingent upon the recipient being enrolled in credit classes at Oklahoma City Community College and maintaining a 2.0 grade point average. Students must reapply for a second semester scholarship award.

Complete the application and return it, along with a copy of your college transcript and a Summary (at least 500 words), to the Arts and Humanities Division Office or the OCCC Foundation Office. The deadline for scholarship applications to be submitted is 5:00 p.m., Friday, October 2, 2009.

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to apply for the Mary Nell Scruggs Holton Scholarship, applicants should meet the following criteria:

1. have the need for financial assistance to attend Oklahoma City Community College
2. have minimum grade point average of 2.5
3. be enrolled in a minimum of 12 credit hours at Oklahoma City Community College
4. be committed to completing an Associate Degree in Music at Oklahoma City Community College

Selection Procedure

The recipient will be selected by the Scholarship Selection Committee. The amount is \$500 each semester for two semesters (total of \$1,000) for tuition, fees, and books. Disbursement for another semester is contingent upon the recipient being enrolled in credit classes at Oklahoma City Community College and maintaining a 2.5 grade point average.
