Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to apply for the Bill and Carol Sechrist Endowed Scholarship Fund, applicants should meet the following criteria:

- 1. Student must have completed at least 24 credit hours with a 3.0 GPA.
- Student must submit a one-page essay telling why he/she wants to take a travelenhanced course and how he/she thinks this will benefit him/her.
- 3. Student will be asked whether he/she is receiving financial aid (or to indicate financial need in some way).
- 4. Student must provide two faculty recommendations.
- Students who receive this award will be asked to make a presentation after they complete their travel-study course.
- Funds are to be used ONLY for OCCC travel-enhanced courses, and students must be enrolled for credit in the course.
