- The current VPESS office is where the front door of OCCC used to be located, prior to the first floor remodel.
- Kim Velleca, Office of the VPESS Administrative Assistant, has been working with Dr. Marion Paden, Vice President for Enrollment and Student Services, for over 13 years. In addition, Dr. Marion Paden has worked at OCCC for over 1/2 of her life.
- The Leadership Council (TLC) was established by Dr. Marion Paden as a student liaison and to engage students in giving voice to decisions that affect the OCCC campus.
- Dr. Marion Paden was recently voted as President Elect of Oklahoma Rotary Club #29, the first Rotary Club in Oklahoma, #29 in the world (which currently has 33,000 clubs in 200 countries), and she will serve the 2012-2013 term.
- Currently, in the Enrollment and Student Services Division, there are a total of 218 employees. With 101 Full-Time employees, 14 Part-Time employees, and 103 Temporary/Work Study employees, this division has consistently grown over the years as the enrollment numbers also increase.
