



Graduation Services



Things of Note

- The Graduation/Transfer Evaluation office is where students apply for graduation, request an official degree check, have transfer transcripts evaluated and receive help with credit for experiential learning as well as request academic forgiveness.
- Upcoming events for the Graduation Department will be Degree-Check-It –Out and The Transfer Fair. Every Fall and Spring semester the Graduation Office conducts a Degree-Check-It –Out event for two days where students can receive an official degree check and also apply for Graduation.
- The Graduation Office also participates in the Transfer Fair in February with the Office of Academic Advising. This helps to promote applying for graduation at OCCC while students also look into transferring to a four year institution.
- Our office is currently in the process of mailing out diplomas to over 450 graduates for the Fall 2010 semester. This is our largest fall graduate class.
- We are also preparing for the Spring 2011 Commencement Ceremony on May, 13, 2011 which will be held in the Cox Convention Center. Letters to participants will be going out in February and caps and gowns will be available for purchase in March in the Bookstore.
