This requirement may be met by transfer of TA 2113 (Introduction to Technical Theatre.) In this case, a lower level elective may replace this requirement in one Fall term.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> A total of 3 credit hours (TA 1121 taken 3 times with different content) will be accepted toward completion of the degree.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup>This course will transfer as an elective for the major field, but does not replace THTR 4510 (credit for professional internship).

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> Students must earn 40 hours of upper-level elective credit. Upper-level THTR electives (see catalog) are offered each term. USAO Theatre Arts majors are encouraged to complete upper-level courses in interdisciplinary study that will strengthen their theatre training (Communication, Music, Art, Photography, Psychology, Speech/Language Pathology, Physical Education, Education, History, Language and Literature, and other fields).

<sup>3</sup>Students are strongly encouraged to take USAO's (3) World Thought and Culture General Education courses as part of this interdisciplinary major.
