





Completion of the graduate exit exam is required

An Associate in Arts degree satisfies the general education requirements (IDS) at USAO.

All Art and elective courses will transfer to USAO and often can be applied to a degree in Art. Some courses may satisfy major requirements, some courses may transfer in as elective credit or some courses may satisfy general education requirements (IDS). Decisions are based on content for course equivalency. Some lower-division courses may be substituted for upper-division courses based on content, but will not count towards required upper division hours. Official transfer evaluations must be conducted by the Registrar. Final determination of transcripts and substitutions of all courses transferring to USAO must be approved by the Registrar and Art Department Coordinator.

A portfolio review by the Art Department Coordinator is required of all transfer students and will assist in determining major requirements.
