Decisions are based on content for course equivalency. Some lower-division courses may be substituted for upper-division courses based on content, but will not count towards required upper division hours. Official transfer evaluations must be conducted by the Registrar. Final determination of transcripts and substitutions of all courses transferring to USAO must be approved by the Registrar and Art Department Coordinator.

A portfolio review by the Art Department Coordinator is required of all transfer students and will assist in determining major requirements.
