







(May be taken at OCCC.) This signifies that a UCO course requirement can be met with the equivalent OCCC course (found on the UCO website). To take this course at OCCC, the student should confirm that it will fit into the associate's degree without exceeding the requirements. A minimum of 60 hours must be taken at a baccalaureate granting institution, so exceeding 64 credit hours at the community college means the student will exceed the minimum of 124 credit hour total. A minimum of 40 hours of 3/4000 level courses are required for the baccalaureate. Courses from community colleges are 1/2000 level.
