Transfer Agreement

Scholarship:

OCCC Transfer Award - 50% Grant on Regular Tuition *

(2020-2021 Estimated Value: \$12,275 annually)*

Eligible OCCC graduates who transfer with an Associate in Arts in Political Science/Pre-Law into the Bachelor of Science in History/Pre-Law program at Oklahoma Christian University will be awarded a 50% Tuition Grant (50% reduction in regular tuition for up to four semesters) to complete the program.

Students who use on-campus housing may be eligible for additional discounting. HRSA subsidized loans are available to students who meet these program and federal qualifications.

***Award applies to admitted candidates from January 1, 2020 to May 31, 2021.**
