



Transfer Agreement Oklahoma City Community College & Oklahoma City University

This transfer agreement is made and entered into by the Division of Business & Information Technology at Oklahoma City Community College, hereinafter referred to as OCCC, and the Meinders School of Business at Oklahoma City University hereinafter referred to as OCU. By this agreement, OCCC and OCU express a shared commitment to increase opportunities for student access to, and success in, higher education. By clarifying transfer policies and procedures that assure articulation between programs, both institutions seek to forge a seamless transfer of the Associate of Science degree in Business at OCCC to the Bachelor of Business Administration degree at OCU.

- OCCC students who complete the Associate in Science in Business (62 credit hours) with a minimum 2.0 GPA will be eligible to apply for admission to the Bachelor of Business Administration degree program at OCU.
- 2. All degree-applicable transfer courses must be completed with a grade of C or better.
- 3. OCCC students who complete the Associate in Science in Business (62 credit hours) and meet the above requirements are considered to have completed their general education requirements, with the following exceptions:
 - All OCU students must complete a Religion course (REL 1003 or REL 1513) if they have not taken an equivalent course. (equivalent OCCC course is included in the degree map below).
 - All OCU students must complete an approved Service Learning course.
- 4. OCU agrees that criteria for acceptance into a baccalaureate degree program will be the same for OCCC transfer students as for students who begin their studies at OCU; with the following exception:
 - Upon transferring to OCU, OCCC students will not be required to take MGMT 1001 Freshman Business Connection. While this course is typically required of the Business Core, OCCC students will take additional elective courses to complete their OCU graduation requirements.
- 5. The transfer agreement will be reviewed and updated periodically by representatives of both institutions to ensure that it remains current and relevant.

If another OCCC course is being proposed to transfer for an OCU credit that does not currently have equivalency, students must submit the course information through <u>OCU's Transfer Evaluation Submission System (TESS)</u>. There is no guarantee the course will be accepted/transferred, therefore it is advised to do this prior to taking the course.

Credited courses completed as part of the A.S. that do not apply to the general education at OCCC or the OCU major transfer to OCU as electives.

Bachelor of Business Administration (B.B.A.) students are required to complete 59 credits in the Business Core. Many of the freshman and sophomore-level Business Core courses have OCCC equivalents and are completed as part of the A.S. in Business at OCCC. The remaining junior and senior-level Business Core courses to be completed at OCU follows. Reflecting the Meinders School's broad view of business administration, the Business Administration major allows students to customize the course work to suit individual interests and professional objectives. Therefore, degree plans that include the following requirements are prepared on an individual basis with the assistance of an academic advisor in the Meinders School of Business.

Students may choose to change from General Business (Business Administration) to a specialized major: Accounting, Economics, Finance, or Marketing. This change may require students to take three additional credit hours to meet graduation requirements. When changes in major occur, the student will meet with an MSB faculty member and work with the business academic advisor to ensure all requirements are being met.

OCU Tuition Costs:

Full-time students pay a flat rate each semester they are enrolled in 12 - 16 credit hours. Tuition

Milestones and Recommended Actions:

- During Year One at OCCC: Students should consider a campus tour at Oklahoma City University. This
 will allow you to connect with your OCU academic advisor, to ensure you are on track to transfer.
- During Year Two at OCCC: Students should apply to the OCU Business Program. (<u>Transfer Application Instructions | Oklahoma City University (okcu.edu)</u>.
- Final semester at OCCC: Be sure to apply for graduation! (<u>Graduation Services Oklahoma City Community College (occc.edu)</u>.
- Transcripts: Submit an official OCCC transcript to OCU (<u>Transcripts Oklahoma City Community College (occc.edu)</u>.
- Reverse Transcript: If you have not earned an Associate in Science from OCCC, and have completed 60 credit hours, with 15 of those hours completed at OCCC, contact OCCC Graduation Services (<u>What is Reverse Transfer? - Oklahoma City Community College (occc.edu)</u> to see if you qualify for a degree through the Reverse Transfer Program.
