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Definition of AtD Cohort and Persistence

- AtD Cohort consists of students who are new to OCCC in the fall semester.
 - New to higher education (OCCC first college attended)
 - New Transfer (transferring credit hours from one or more other higher education institutions to OCCC for the first time)
 - No Concurrents
- Persistence student from AtD Cohort enrolls in following spring semester




Composition of AtD Cohorts Five Year Look – AGE GROUPS




Average Age = 23

Median Age = 20






Composition of AtD Cohorts Ten Year Look – ETHNICITY/RACE






Composition of AtD Cohorts Five Year Look: Non-White Groups





Composition of AtD Cohorts Ten Year Look – Applied for Financial Aid


Increased 20.4 percentage points






Composition of AtD Cohorts FAFSA Applicants – EFC GROUPS

65.7% of AtD Cohort completed a FAFSA for Fall 2016






Composition of AtD Cohorts Nine Year Look – Enrolled in Zero-Level Course






Headcount and Persistence of AtD Cohorts






Persistence of AtD Cohorts Ten Year Look - GENDER






Persistence of AtD Cohorts Ten Year Look – Age Groups






Persistence of AtD Cohorts Five Year Look – ETHNICITY/RACE






Persistence of AtD Cohorts Ten Year Look - Applied for Financial Aid vs. Did Not Apply






Persistence of AtD Cohorts Five Year Look – EFC Above and Below \$10K






Persistence of AtD Cohorts Nine Year Look – Enrolled in Zero-Level Course

Summary

- The persistence rate in the 2016 AtD cohort dropped slightly (-0.5) to 58.8% overall.
- The racial/ethnic composition of the 2016 AtD cohort (new and new transfers) continues to evolve with the increasing proportion of Hispanics and students of Two or More races compared to other groups in the cohort.
- The gap in the rate of persistence between the ethnic/racial groups in the AtD cohorts has narrowed substantially in the last five years.
- The percentage of the AtD cohort completing the FAFSA at 65.7% is the highest it has been in 10 years.
- Students completing the FAFSA continue to persist at a higher rate than their counterparts though this gap is narrowing.
