- 2. The number located within parentheses is the number of graduates responding to the question.
- 3. Jobs are listed for those jobs in which the graduates indicated the jobs were directly or somewhat directly related to the graduate's major.
- 4. All questions which asked graduates to rate an item were calculated from low to high with the lowest selection receiving a "1" and the highest receiving the highest rating in the category.
- 5. Wages are based on graduates who work full time and reported that their job was directly or somewhat directly related to their major.
