1. Each question includes responses from at least 4 graduates.
2. The number located within parentheses is the number of graduates responding to the question.
3. Jobs are listed for those jobs in which the graduates indicated the jobs were directly or somewhat directly related to the graduate's major.
4. All questions which asked graduates to rate an item were calculated from low to high with the lowest selection receiving a "1" and the highest receiving the highest rating in the category.
5. Wages are based on graduates who work full time and reported that their job was directly or somewhat directly related to their major.
