


## Finding Your Courses in Moodle

Finding your courses in Moodle is easy! After you log in to Moodle, you will be taken to the Moodle home page:



Scrolling down on this page will reveal some information about the Institutional Statements and Policies, information regarding enrollment dates, and the My Courses list:



Selecting a course from this list will take you to the course's home page where you can begin to access the course content by selecting a topic in the CONTENTS area:
