When conjugating a verb/infinitive, use the following steps.

- 1. Drop the ending of the verb/infinitive (ar, er, ir)
- 2. When the ending is dropped you are left with the "stem."
- 3. Add the endings to the verb/infinitive.

An infinitive means, "to do" something.
