Teaching Goal Example

Goal

 I want to increase student engagement in my courses.

SMART Goal

• I will add one high engagement activity in each class in each course I teach by January 2021.

Tip: write a general goal statement and then revise it to be SMART goal.



Teaching Goal Example

Goal

• I want to integrate technology assignments into my courses.

SMART Goal

• I will add a blogging project to COMP 1 Spring semester courses.

Tip: Your goals can focus on one course! The scope of your goal is up to you.



Teaching Goal Example

Goal

• I want more students to pass my biology course.

SMART Goal

• I will increase my fall semester biology course grade average to a 3.0.

Tip: Some goals are "stretch" goals! Even if you're not sure how to do something, this is the first step to thinking about how you would! And just because a goal is challenging, doesn't mean you shouldn't strive for it!



Service Goal Example

Goal

• I will help with curriculum development.

SMART Goal

• I will serve on a team to redesign COMP1 curriculum by March 2022.

Tip: Goals can be things you're engaged in and already in the process of!



Service Goal Example

Goal

• I will participate in a student club.

SMART Goal

• I will sponsor a student creative writing club throughout the FY22.

Tip: Goals can be something new you want to implement!



Service Goal Example

Goal

• I will participate in student life events.

SMART Goal

• I will participate in 4 student life events by May 2022.

Tip: Participating in events on campus can be a service goal!



Leadership Goal Example

Goal

• I will attend training for leadership.

SMART Goal

• I will attend all sessions of OCCC Resilient Leadership training in FY22.

Tip: Attending & completing already scheduled professional development can be a goal!



Leadership Goal Example

Goal

• I will meet with my direct reports.

SMART Goal

• I will meet with my direct reports individually once per week at a minimum.

Tip: Improving your communication with staff can be a goal!

Teaching	I want more students to pass my biology course.	I will increase my fall semester biology course grade average to a 3.0.	*Department dependent	Close the academic achievement gap with low-income, first-generation, and minority students.
