

Moodle Technical Requirements

Moodle is compatible with most modern PCs and Macs, and many Mobile devices as well. The most important thing to ensure compatibility is that you keep your browser updated.

PCs and Macs

For PCs and Macs, the Center for Learning and Teaching recommends using the newest version available of the following browsers:

Chrome – <u>download here</u>

Firefox – download here

Cookies and JavaScript must be enabled in your browser for Moodle to function properly.

Mobile Devices

For mobile devices it is recommended to use your device's native browser. Also, when accessing Moodle from a Mobile device, keep in mind that some features may not function properly. It is not advised to take exams or quizzes, or to submit homework from a mobile device. You can also download the Moodle App <u>here</u>.

Plugins and Other Software

Some resources in your courses, such as videos or multimedia, may require up to date plugins to function correctly. Links to some commonly used plugins can be found below:

<u>Office 365</u> – As an OCCC student you get free access to the Microsoft Office suite. This link provides instructions for accessing and installing Office on your computer.

<u>Adobe Flash Player</u> – NOTE: Be sure to uncheck the "Optional Offers" listed on this page before downloading the player. Chrome users will not need to install flash as it is built-in to the browser.

<u>Adobe Reader</u> – NOTE: Be sure to uncheck the "Optional Offers" listed on this page before downloading the player.

<u>Microsoft Silverlight</u> – NOTE: Silverlight is not compatible with Chrome.
