Oklahoma City Community College and University of Central Oklahoma Transfer Agreement

The University of Central Oklahoma (UCO), in collaboration with Oklahoma City Community College (OCCC), participates in articulated transfer agreements to assist students in transferring smoothly from the associate degree to the baccalaureate degree. Transfer policies are available in the [Introduction for Program-to-Program Agreements](#). These agreements express a shared commitment to student access and success in higher education.

OCCC Associate in Arts – History to UCO Bachelor of Arts in Education – History Education

This document specifies courses from OCCC which will apply to this UCO major.

Associate in Arts (A.A.) – History

Students should refer to [Oklahoma City Community College](#) for associate degree requirements and an academic advisor to ensure a successful transition to UCO.

Oklahoma City Community College General Education

An Associate in Science (A.S.) or Associate in Arts (A.A.) degree from an accredited Oklahoma institution that includes the OSRHE minimum requirements will satisfy the UCO University Core. The associate degree included in this agreement meets the UCO University Core requirements. It is highly recommended that students work with their academic advisors to make the best general education choices. Courses may meet both a general education requirement and a UCO support course or major requirement.

OCCC Courses Meeting UCO Major Requirements

The courses listed in this section meet a UCO support course or major course requirement. The OCCC course is followed by the UCO equivalent or substituted course.

- ENGL 1113 English Composition I (UCO course ENG 1113 English Composition)
- ENGL 1213 English Composition II (UCO course ENG 1213 English Composition and Research)
- Foreign Language (Proficiency in foreign language at a Novice 4 level)
- COM 2213 Intro to Public Speaking (UCO course MCOM 1113 Fundamentals of Speech)
- HIST 1613 Early Western Civilization (UCO course HIST 1103 Early Western Civilization to 1350)
- HIST 1623 Modern Western Civilization (UCO course HIST 1203 Europe from the Renaissance to Waterloo)
- HIST 1483 U.S. History to 1877 (UCO course HIST 1483 History of the United States to 1877)
- HIST 1493 U.S. History 1877 to Present (UCO course HIST 1493 History of the United States Since 1877)

- HIST 1713 Survey World Civ to 1600 (UCO course HIST 1013 World History I)
- HIST 1723 Survey World Civ Since 1600 (UCO course HIST 1023 World History II)
- GEOG 2603 World Regional Geography (UCO course GEO 2303 Regional Geography of the World)

Additional courses which may be taken at OCCC:

The following courses are not required at OCCC but will apply to the UCO major if taken.

- ECON 1013 Introduction to Economics (UCO course ECON 1103 Introduction to Economics)
- SOC 1113 Sociology (UCO course SOC 2103 Sociology)
- POLSC 2603 Introduction to Comparative Politics (UCO course POL 2713 Introduction to Comparative Politics)
- HIST 2103 Oklahoma History (UCO course HIST 3303 Oklahoma History)

Additional Coursework for the A.A. or A.S.

Credited courses completed as part of the A.A. or A.S. that do not meet a specific UCO degree requirement transfer to UCO as electives. Students should consult an academic advisor to determine how elective courses apply toward the bachelor's degree. Bachelor of Arts in Education (B.A.Ed.) – History Education

Degree requirements for this major are found in the current [UCO Undergraduate Catalog](#). Degree requirements for previous catalog years are available in the UCO Undergraduate Archives. Confer with a UCO academic advisor for appropriate catalog year eligibility.

Degree Requirement Minimums for All Programs/Majors

Students must meet all bachelor's degree requirements at UCO to include minimums of:

- 40 hours of upper division coursework
- 30 hours in residence at UCO
- 15 of the last 30 hours must be taken in residence at UCO
- 60 hours from baccalaureate granting institutions
- 124 hours
